Road Resurfacing in York South-Weston

Contract: 24ECS-RD-13LR

Previous End Date: November 22, 2024 | New End Date: Summer 2025

In summer 2024, the City started road resurfacing work on listed streets below. Due to weather conditions and scheduling delays, the contractor was unable to complete the road resurfacing work. The City’s contractor will return to complete the remaining work on these streets in spring 2025 when conditions are more favorable. The contractor will make the site safe and serviceable prior to the winter shutdown. Another Notice will be distributed before work starts in 2025.

REMAINING WORK IN YORK SOUTH-WESTON

The City’s contractor will return on:

- **Cameron Avenue** to complete driveway and sod restoration.
- **Cornelius Parkway** to complete driveway and sod restoration.
- **Edison Circle** to complete concrete driveway restoration.
- **Glenhaven Street** to complete driveway and sod restoration.
- **Gracefield Avenue** to resurface the street.
- **Holwood Avenue** to complete driveway and sod restoration.
- **Lookout Place** to complete driveway and sod restoration.
- **Scott Road** to complete driveway and sod restoration.
- **Springview Avenue** to complete driveway and sod restoration.
- **Strathnairn Avenue** to complete driveway and sod restoration.
- **Suntract Road** to complete driveway and sod restoration.
