Watermain Replacement and Road Resurfacing on Cranfield Road from Dohme Avenue to Waterman Avenue


Contract: 25ECS-LU-07SU NEW Start Date: April 14, 2025 NEW End Date: June 13, 2025 *Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on resurfacing the road and replacing the watermain and the Cityowned portion of substandard water services on Cranfield Road from Dohme Avenue to Waterman Avenue.

The water service is the underground pipe that brings water to your water meter and is owned by you <u>and</u> by the City. The part you own is from your house to your property line, and the part the City owns is from the property line to the watermain.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Capital Works Program to renew our aging infrastructure, improve water distribution and reduce the risk of watermain breaks.

The start date has been delayed on this project due to unavoidable construction conflicts on other streets that are part of the contract.



WORK DETAILS

Work crews will:

- Excavate the road and dig a trench to access and install the new watermain
- Replace any City-owned water service pipes that do not meet City standards from the watermain to the private property line.
- Replace curb
- Resurface the road and watermain trench

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

Construction Update #1

	Work Hours : Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
8	Traffic Management : Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.
	Traffic on Cranfield Road will be reduced to one lane.
	Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
☆	Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.
GTO	People Cycling: Travel will be reduced to one shared lane in each direction for people cycling and driving through the work zone.
\mathbf{R}	Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
	Parking Violation Notice : <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all</u> <u>times.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:
	 Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) <u>or</u> File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction.
	If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy.
	Please note : Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (e.g. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).
	In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.
Ġ	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
