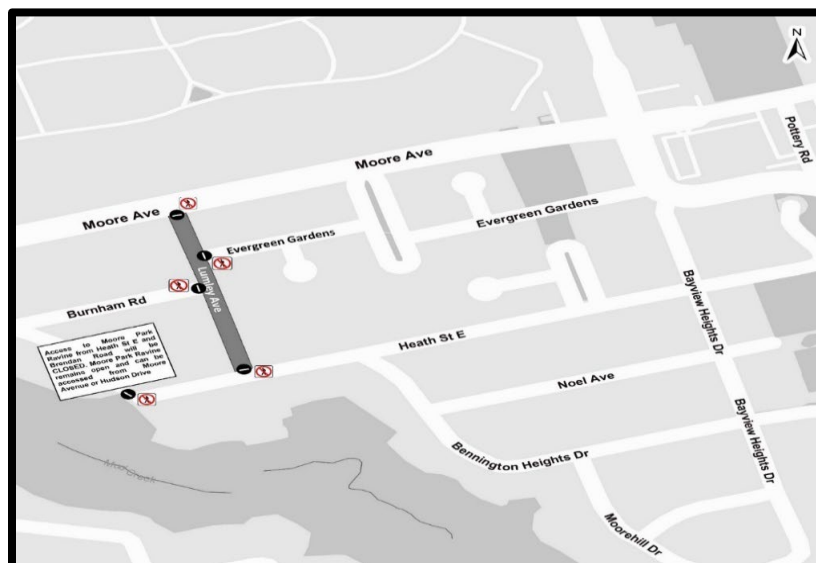
Current construction on Lumley Avenue involves replacing the city-owned portion of substandard water services and sanitary sewer laterals which requires digging within the city's right of way on the boulevard.

Due to the continuation of the construction work and to avoid safety concerns, Lumley Avenue will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian through traffic. This closure will affect access to Lumley Avenue at the intersections of Burnham Road, Evergreen Gardens, Heath Street East, and Moore Avenue, **effective from 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 23, 2025, to 7:00 p.m. on Friday, May 2, 2025.** Residents living on Lumley Avenue will have access to the road and their driveway during this time.





We apologize for any inconvenience that this closure will cause, and we thank you for your continued patience as we complete the work.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2022 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system; renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.
	Pedestrians: Pedestrian access to Lumley Avenue will be restricted at the intersections of Burnham Road, Evergreen Gardens, Heath Street East, and Moore Avenue.
	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.
	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible driveways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
