Road Reconstruction on Knox Avenue from Eastern Avenue to Lake Shore Boulevard East

Contract: 23ECS-RD-10SP

Start Date: September 2024 New End Date: Summer 2025

This notice provides an update on the road reconstruction on Knox Avenue from Eastern Avenue to Lake Shore Boulevard East.

Starting in April 2025, the contractor will complete the road reconstruction and cycle track improvements with the installation of the two-way cycle track on the west side of Knox Avenue.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

The City's contractor has:

- Replaced the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services.





REMAINING WORK

In April 2025 the contractor will:

- Remove the road surface and road base materials
- Install a new concrete road base and new asphalt
- Install the two-way cycle track on the west side
- Upgrade traffic signals at Eastern Avenue
- Restore driveways and other areas impacted by construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
	On-Site Communication: There are times when contractors need to communicate with facility's management about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access, water shut offs, pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility company branded clothing. If you need to speak with staff about the construction site, please contact the Public Consultation contact listed below or ask for the Site Inspector.
	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Vehicle travel on Knox Avenue will be limited to one lane to accommodate northbound traffic <u>only</u> between Knox Avenue and Eastern Avenue.

	Garbage and Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i>
	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
