

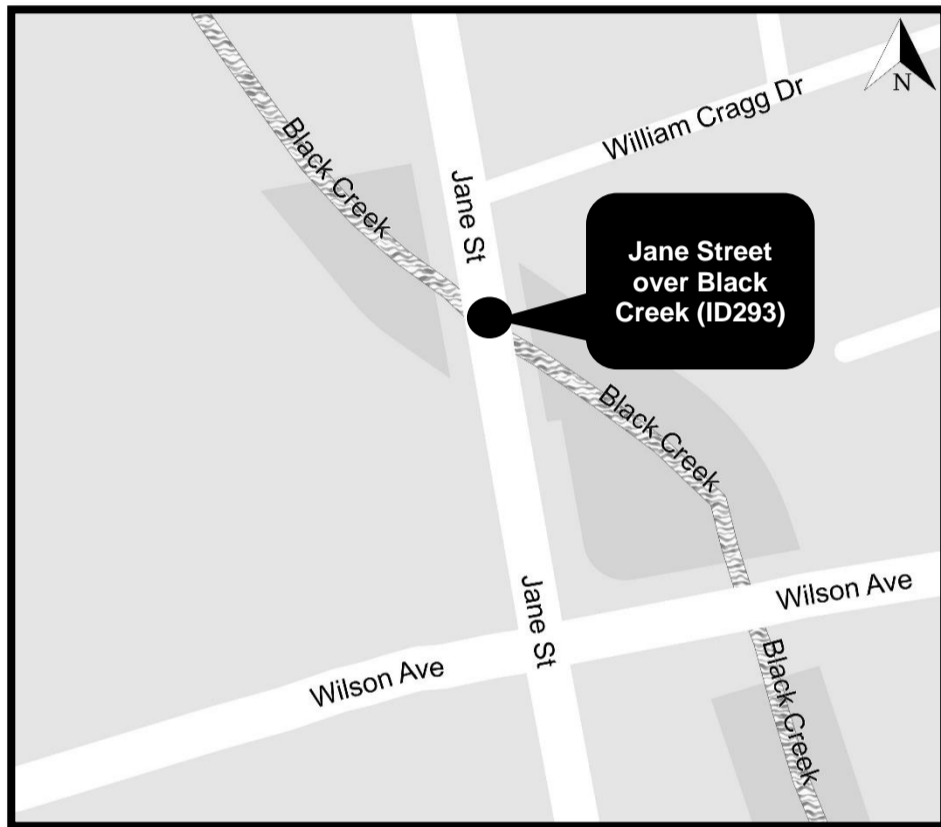

Jane Street over Black Creek Bridge Rehabilitation

Contract: 25ECS-BE-04PM
Start Date: April 2025 End Date: March 2026

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Bridge at Jane Street over Black Creek. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today’s standards and remains safe into the future. Further details will be provided in an upcoming Construction Notice. The project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS






The City’s contractor will:

- Reconstruct the concrete sidewalks, parapet walls, railings and approach slabs;
- Resurface the approach roadway;
- Patch repair the concrete deck, abutments, wingwalls and retaining walls;
- Replace bridge bearings;
- Blast clean and recoat the structural steel girders; and
- Replace the asphalt surface and waterproofing.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturdays. No work will occur on Sundays and Statutory holidays unless approved.</p>
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	<p>Pre-Construction Inspection: The City hired contractor will conduct inspections of properties within 30 metres of the construction area before construction starts. Affected properties will receive a separate notice to set up an appointment for the inspection.</p> <p>The inspection will look at the exterior and interior of properties to verify existing conditions. Although participation is voluntary, the City encourages all property owners to participate. Without the survey, it will be difficult to confirm any claims of damage caused by construction. All inspection staff will wear photo I.D. and carry photo equipment for this work.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>At least one sidewalk will remain open at all times. Temporary signage will direct pedestrians to safely cross the bridge.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Road users might expect minor delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Temporary concrete barriers and pylons will be placed on Jane Street, with single-lane reductions in each direction.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
