# Collingsbrook Boulevard Culvert Replacement over West Highland Creek

Contract: 23ECS-BE-07BSE

Start Date: May 2025 End Date: September 2025



The City of Toronto is replacing the Culvert at Collingsbrook Boulevard over the West Highland Creek.

This update notice includes details of the full road and sidewalk closures to expedite construction. More information is in the "Traffic Management" and "Pedestrians" sections of this notice.

This work will ensure that the culvert meets today's standards and remains safe into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

#### **WORK DETAILS**

The City's contractor will:

- Replace the existing culvert at Collingsbrook Boulevard over West Highland Creek.
- Remove existing concrete retaining walls, and installation of precast concrete retaining walls.
- Remove and replace gabion baskets to facilitate construction access.
- Install chain-link fence above new retaining walls.
- Roadway reconstruction and active transportation works including paving, waterproofing and boulevard works.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

• You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

<b>(</b> J)	<b>Work Hours</b> : Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
<b>\$</b>	<b>Traffic Management</b> : Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.
	There will be no pedestrian or vehicular access to Collingsbrook Boulevard over West Highland Creek; Collingsbrook Boulevard will be fully closed between 136 Collingsbrook Boulevard to 162 Collingsbrook Boulevard.
	Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk closures within the construction work zone.
	<b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
广	Pedestrians: Temporary sidewalk restrictions will be in place during construction. Pedestrian access on Collingsbrook Boulevard over West Highland Creek will not be available. Pedestrians can use Collingsbrook Parkette Trail as an alternative route.
Ė	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the field ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.
	City Owned Trees: Due to the nature of this project, the City will have to remove 45 trees throughout the City's boulevard on Collingsbrook Boulevard over West Highland Creek. If the planned work affects a tree near your property, you will receive a separate notice in advance of the work. After construction is completed, new trees will be planted on streets where there is sufficient space in the boulevard, in parks and ravine areas. The City plants three trees for every one tree that is removed due to construction.
