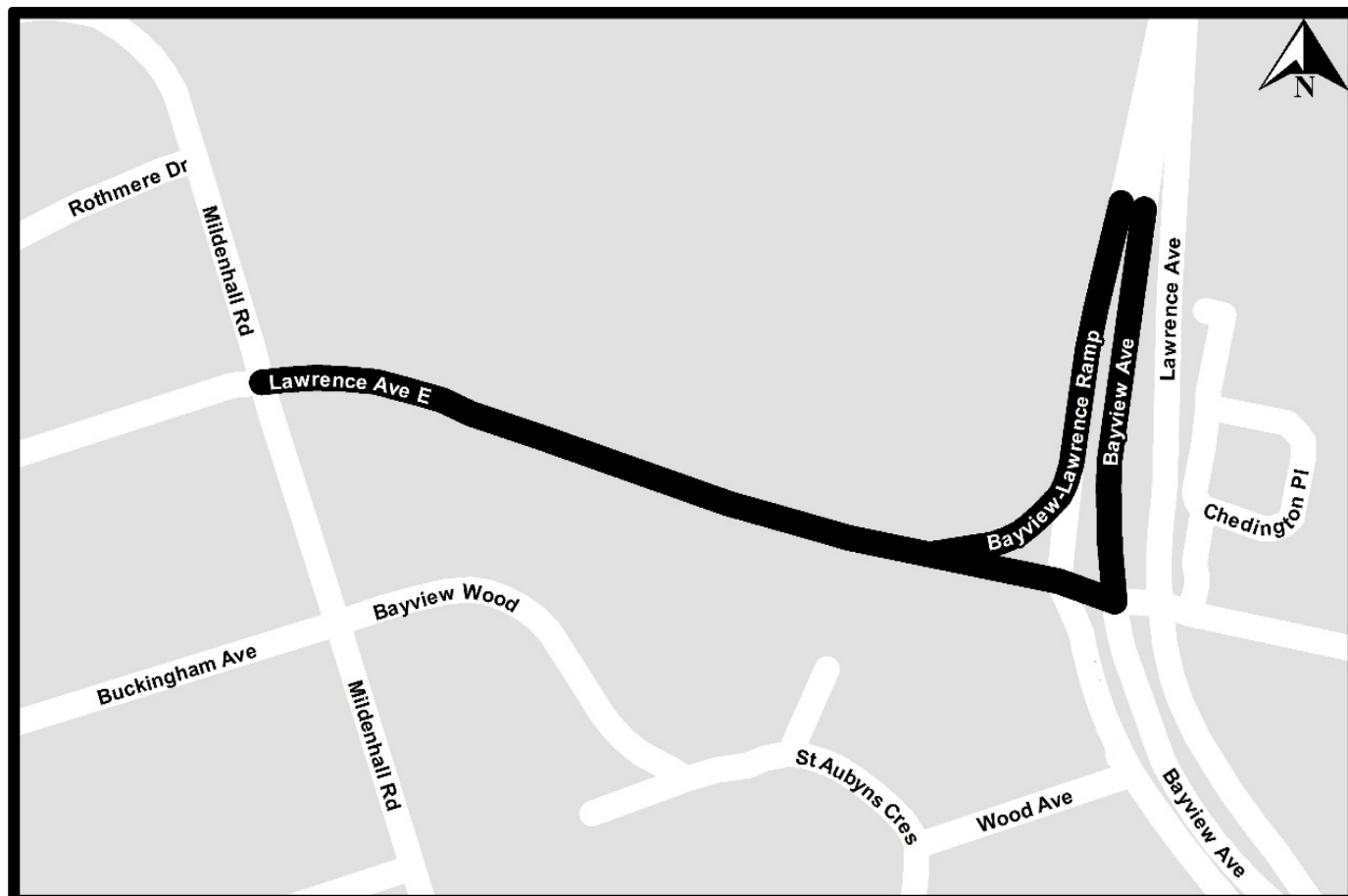

This notice provides an update on the construction work involving the replacement of watermain, the City-owned portion of substandard water services and road resurfacing on Bayview Avenue from Lawrence Avenue East to 143 meters north of Lawrence Avenue East; and on Lawrence Avenue East from Mildenhall Road to Bayview Avenue Road.

Following the winter shutdown, construction activities are tentatively expected to resume on May 2, 2025, weather permitting. Bayview Avenue westbound ramp to Lawrence Avenue East will experience overnight work with full road closure from **Friday, May 2 at 7:00 p.m. to Saturday, May 3 at 11:59 p.m.** This closure is required to safely complete the proposed road resurfacing work.
