

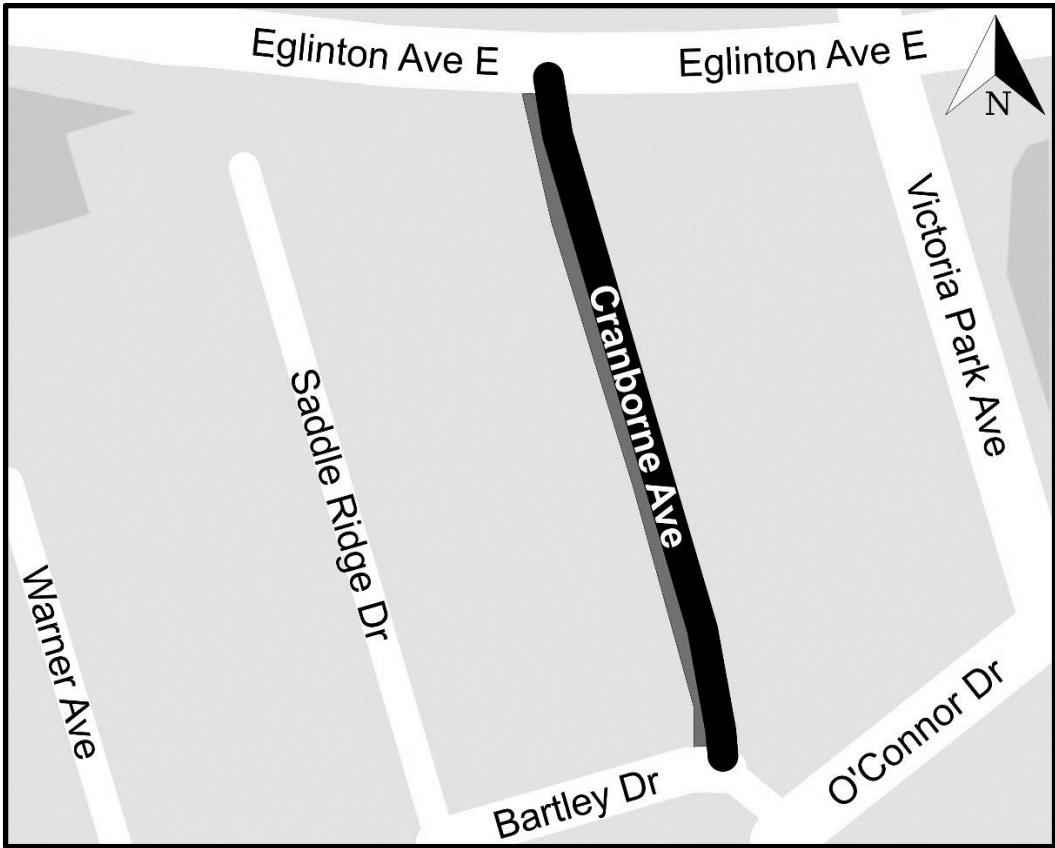

Watermain Replacement and Road Resurfacing on Cranborne Avenue

Contract: 23ECS-RD-02LR
 Start Date: September 2024 | End Date: July 2025

The City of Toronto contractor will be returning to complete road resurfacing on Cranbourne Avenue starting on May 5, 2025. We anticipate that road works will be completed by June 13, 2025.

The City’s contractor has completed:


- Watermain installation
- Replacement of substandard water services







REMAINING WORK

Work Crews will be working on:

- Repair sections of curb and sidewalk
- Milling of asphalt surface
- Resurfacing of asphalt roadway
- Pavement markings
- Restoration

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
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	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Traffic on Cranborne Avenue will be reduced to one lane.
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p>Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Local Roads Enquiries email listed below.</p>
	<p>Important information for owners of sprinkler systems / heated driveways and private landscaping features. Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.</p> <p>This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. If you have a sprinkler system or heated driveway, please contact the Local Roads Enquiries email listed below.</p>
