
As road work progress on Sentinel Road the next phase of road reconstruction work Sheppard Avenue to Lamberton Road will restrict the current 106 Sentinel bus service from using Sentinel Avenue. From April 28 to July 25 TTC bus service (106 Sentinel Road) will use a diversion route as the road construction is completed.

## TTC BUS SERVICE DIVERSION MAP

#### 106 Sentinel Bus Diversion Information

- Westbound: from Sheppard West Station via west on Sheppard Avenue West, north on Keele Street, west on Finch Avenue West, north on Sentinel Road, west and north on The Pond Road, and northeast on Ian Macdonald Boulevard, north on Northwest Gate to Pioneer Village Station.
- **Eastbound:** from Pioneer Village Station via west on Howard Moscoe Way, south on Northwest Gate, west and south on Ian Macdonald Boulevard, south and east on The Pond Road, south on Sentinel Road, and east on Sheppard Avenue West to Sheppard West Station.

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



**Work Hours**: Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Important information for owners of sprinkler systems / heated driveways and private landscaping features. Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.

This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. If you have a sprinkler system or heated driveway, please contact the **Project Contact** listed below.



**Road and Sidewalk Access:** In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

**Driveway Access:** The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be maintained at all times.



**Traffic Management**: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

Local traffic on Sentinel Road will be maintained with lane restrictions.



**Parking:** This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.



**Garbage and Recycling**: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. *Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.* 



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the **Project Contact** listed below.
