Gardiner Expressway Strategic Rehabilitation: Section 3 Early Works on Five Bridges | Community Update

Overnight Closure of Park Lawn Road - May 24 -25

Starting at **11 p.m. on Saturday, May 24 until 11 a.m. on Sunday, May 25**, the contractor is scheduled to remove the centre median portion of the Gardiner Expressway that runs over Park Lawn Road.

To safely complete this work, a **full overnight closure of Park Lawn Road** will be required from the Park Lawn Road on-ramp to the Gardiner Expressway westbound (north limit) to the Gardiner Expressway eastbound off-ramp to Park Lawn Road (south limit).

The demolition work is scheduled overnight to minimize traffic impacts and help ensure the safety of both the travelling public and construction crews. It is expected to be completed in one night.

During the closure:

- The Park Lawn Road on-ramp towards Gardiner Expressway westbound will remain open for the duration of the work.
- The Gardiner Expressway eastbound off-ramp to Park Lawn Road will only have access to southbound Park Lawn Road for the duration of the work.
- Northbound traffic on Park Lawn Road from the off-ramp will be closed for the duration of the full closure noted above.
- Signage will be posted.

Preparatory Work Ahead of Closure - Starting May 12

In advance of the full closure, preparatory work is required, and is scheduled to occur starting Monday, May 12 from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. for a minimum of three nights and up to five nights.

During this preparatory work, the following lane closures will occur:

- One left-turn lane from the Gardiner Eastbound Off-Ramp to Park Lawn Road Northbound will be closed.
- A minimum of one lane in each direction will remain open on Park Lawn Road
- The Park Lawn On-Ramp to the Gardiner Westbound will remain open.
