St. Clair - Topham Park Basement Flooding Protection Program Public Information Meeting

Meet the project team, learn about the project, and ask questions

As part of the Basement Flooding Protection Program (BFPP), the City has commenced work in the St. Clair – Topham Park area. Work includes modifying and upgrading storm and sanitary sewers on St. Clair Avenue East and on various streets in the Topham Park neighbourhood. It also includes watermain replacement and intersection improvements along Westview Boulevard. Additionally, a rain garden will be installed in the median of Valor Boulevard.

This is the third and final part of a larger, hydraulically connected basement flooding protection project for the area. The three phases include O'Connor Drive (completed in November 2024), Glenwood Crescent (completed in 2021), and now this final phase in the St. Clair Avenue East and Topham Park area. Since these upgrades are designed to work as an integrated system, the full flood protection benefits will only be realized once this final phase is complete.

Construction commenced on the St. Clair Avenue East phase in May 2025 and temporary restoration will be completed in 2025. Work on the overall project is anticipated to be completed in 2027.


