

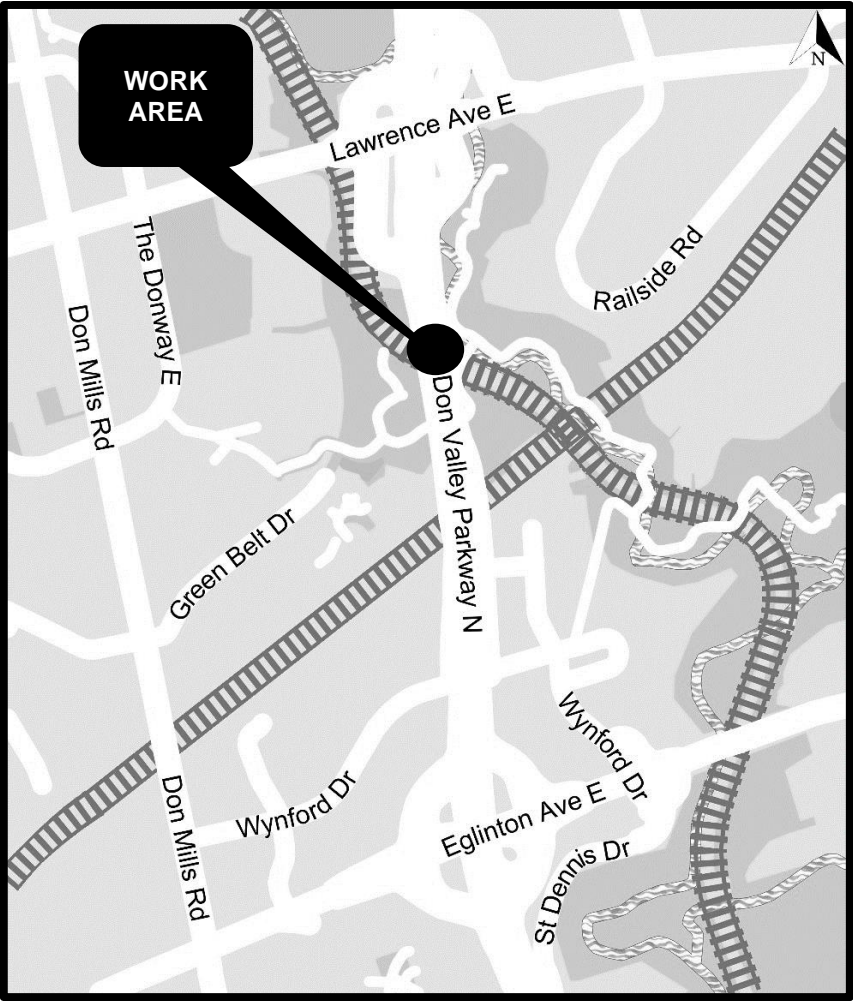

Don Valley Parkway under Metrolinx Rail Bridge Rehabilitation

Contract: 23ECS-BE-04BSE
Start Date: June 2025 End Date: October 2025

The City of Toronto will rehabilitate the Don Valley Parkway (DVP) Bridge under Metrolinx Rail. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS



- The City’s contractor will:
- Repair and refurbish the existing Don Valley Parkway Bridge under Metrolinx Rail.
 - Repair the concrete abutments, pier, deck soffit, deck fascia and wingwalls.
 - Replace existing stone veneer on wingwalls.
 - Seal concrete surfaces including polyurethane liner.
 - Restore roadway/embankment in front of the abutments, pier and wingwalls.

Construction will take place in the following stages:

Stage	Location	Dates	Traffic Management
1 & 1A (nights)	Abutment Walls, Deck Soffit, Wingwalls	May to August 2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All lanes on the DVP will be maintained but up to two lanes may be closed nightly in both directions
2 & 2A (nights)	Bridge Pier and Deck Soffit	August to October 2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All lanes on the DVP will be maintained but up to two lanes may be closed nightly in both directions

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required. The Contractor on this project may use extended work hours as much as possible to minimize traffic disruption and to shorten the project duration.</p> <p>Overnight Work Hours: Work on this project may also take place from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. (and up to 8 a.m. on weekends) based on the nature of the work. During overnight hours, activities such as concrete repairs, shifting traffic barriers, and delivery of materials may take place intermittently.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on the DVP and on nearby main and side streets.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Traffic lanes on southbound DVP will be reduced to two lanes at night.Traffic lanes on northbound DVP will be reduced to one or two lanes at night.
