

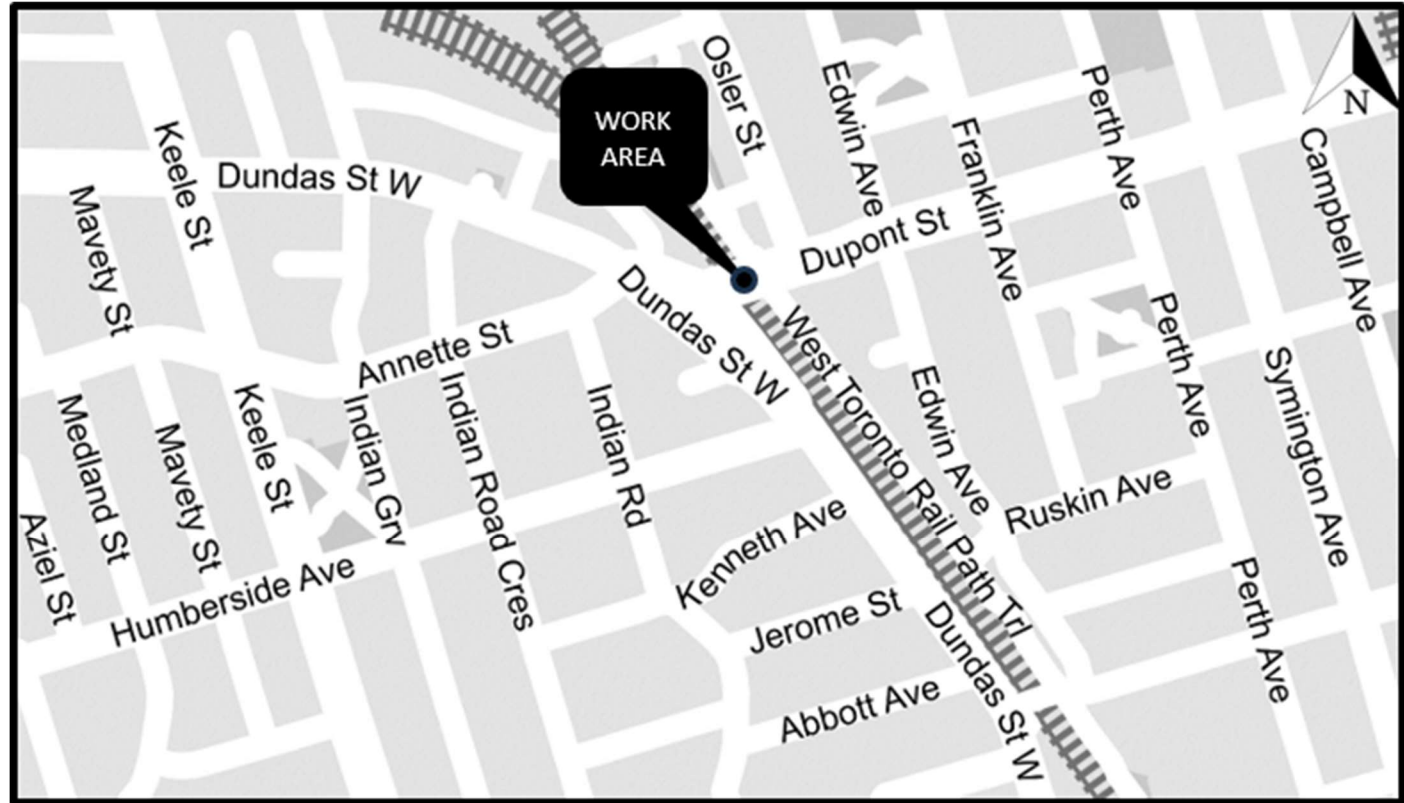

Dupont Street Bridge Rehabilitation under Metrolinx Rail

Contract: 24ECS-BE-15PM
 Start Date: April 2025 End Date: September 2025

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Dupont Street Bridge under Metrolinx Rail. This work will ensure that the bridge and road meet today’s standards and remain safe into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

- The City’s contractor will:
- Repair and refurbish the Dupont Street bridge under Metrolinx Rail.
 - Replace parts of sidewalks and sidewalk railing..
 - Repair steel railings on retaining walls and reconstruct retaining wall copings.
 - Patch repair of the structural sidewalks, abutments, median barriers and wingwalls, concrete deck soffit.
 - Replace bird screen, electrical conduits, streetlights and concrete surface sealing.
 - Roadway resurfacing in the bridge area.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturdays. No work will occur on Sundays and Statutory holidays unless necessary.</p>

	<p>Pre-Construction Inspection: The City hired contractor will conduct inspections of properties within 30 metres of the construction area before construction starts. Affected properties will receive a separate notice to set up an appointment for the inspection.</p> <p>The inspection will look at the exterior and interior of properties to verify existing conditions. Although participation is voluntary, the City encourages all property owners to participate. Without the survey, it will be difficult to confirm any claims of damage caused by construction. All inspection staff will wear photo I.D. and carry photo equipment for this work.</p>
	<p>Sidewalk Access: To complete the work safely, road and sidewalk restrictions will be within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Sidewalk closures will occur during certain construction phases, redirecting pedestrians and bicyclists to either side of the street.</p> <p>West Toronto Railpath Access:</p> <p><u>Access to the railpath at the Dupont Street Bridge will be closed during construction.</u> Please use the Osler Street laneway for access to the railpath north of the workzone, and Ruskin Avenue for access to the railpath south of the workzone.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <p>During construction there will be lane closures on Dupont Street and Dundas Street West from Edwin Avenue to Annette Street and Brad Street. At least one lane in each direction will be maintained.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. Stepped riding surfaces for bicycles shall be smoothed with temporary asphalt. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
