Downsview Major Streets Environmental Assessment Notice of Study Commencement

Over the next 30 years, Downsview will be re-developed to become a resilient, sustainable, and equitable community where people live, work, shop, play, learn, and relax. There will be an estimated 110,000 new residents and 47,000 new jobs across 15 new districts in Downsview.

The City of Toronto is leading the Downsview Major Streets Environmental Assessment (EA) study which will determine the alignment and design of four new major streets (two east-west and two north-south), as well as two rail underpasses and other related infrastructure. See Study Process below. At the current stage, the EA has evaluated and will present recommendations on the following (online now and at an upcoming virtual public meeting):

- Dufferin Street Extension alignment at Wilson Avenue
- Transit Road and Billy Bishop Way Extension alignments at Wilson Avenue
- Location of North-South Dedicated Bus Lanes (Dufferin Street or Billy Bishop Way)

The EA process includes identifying the problem or opportunity to be addressed, developing and evaluating a range of alternative solutions, providing opportunities for public input, and identifying a preferred solution.






Public Consultation

Study Area and Scope

Downsview Major Streets Phases 3-4 EA Study includes design recommendations for the following:

- Two new north-south complete streets:
 - Dufferin Street Extension (Wilson Avenue to Sheppard Avenue West)
 - o Billy Bishop Way Extension (Wilson Avenue to Sheppard Avenue West)
- Dedicated bus lanes along one of the north-south streets
- Two new east-west complete streets with underpasses crossing the GO Barrie Line:
 - o Downsview Park Boulevard Extension (Stanley Greene Boulevard to Allen Road)
 - Northern East/West Street (Keele Street to Sheppard Avenue West)
- Dufferin Street complete street upgrades from Wilson Avenue to Highway 401
- Portions of the Green Spine (3 km active transportation and green infrastructure route)
- Major municipal servicing infrastructure (water, sanitary and stormwater), including a new sanitary sewer through Downsview Park
