Road Conversion from one-way to two-way traffic Kane Avenue from Dunraven Drive to Donald Avenue

Contract #: 21ECS-LU-01TT and 23ECS-MI-02FS

Start Date: Ongoing

End Date: Summer 2027*

The City of Toronto is advancing construction of a new storm sewer system that will collect, store and move stormwater (rain and melted snow) from the Fairbank-Silverthorn area to Black Creek. This work is part of the City's Basement Flooding Protection Program to help reduce the risk of future basement flooding. Once complete, the new storm sewer system will help to reduce the impact of heavy rainfall and sewer back-ups for more than 4,600 homes in your area.

Construction of the storm trunk tunnel and shaft was completed in April 2025 under Contract # 21ECS-LU-01TT. Restoration of this work will be completed by June 2025.

During this next phase, the City's contractor will be connecting new storm sewers to the main tunnel as part of continued works under Contract # 23ECS-MI-02FS, which is expected to be completed in Summer 2027.

This notice is to inform you that the current traffic arrangement on Kane Avenue will be maintained until Summer 2027. The traffic conversion from one-way to two-way traffic on Kane Avenue from Dunraven Drive to Donald Avenue will continue to help relieve congestion and improve surrounding traffic in the community. The current traffic conversion that will remain in place is as follows:

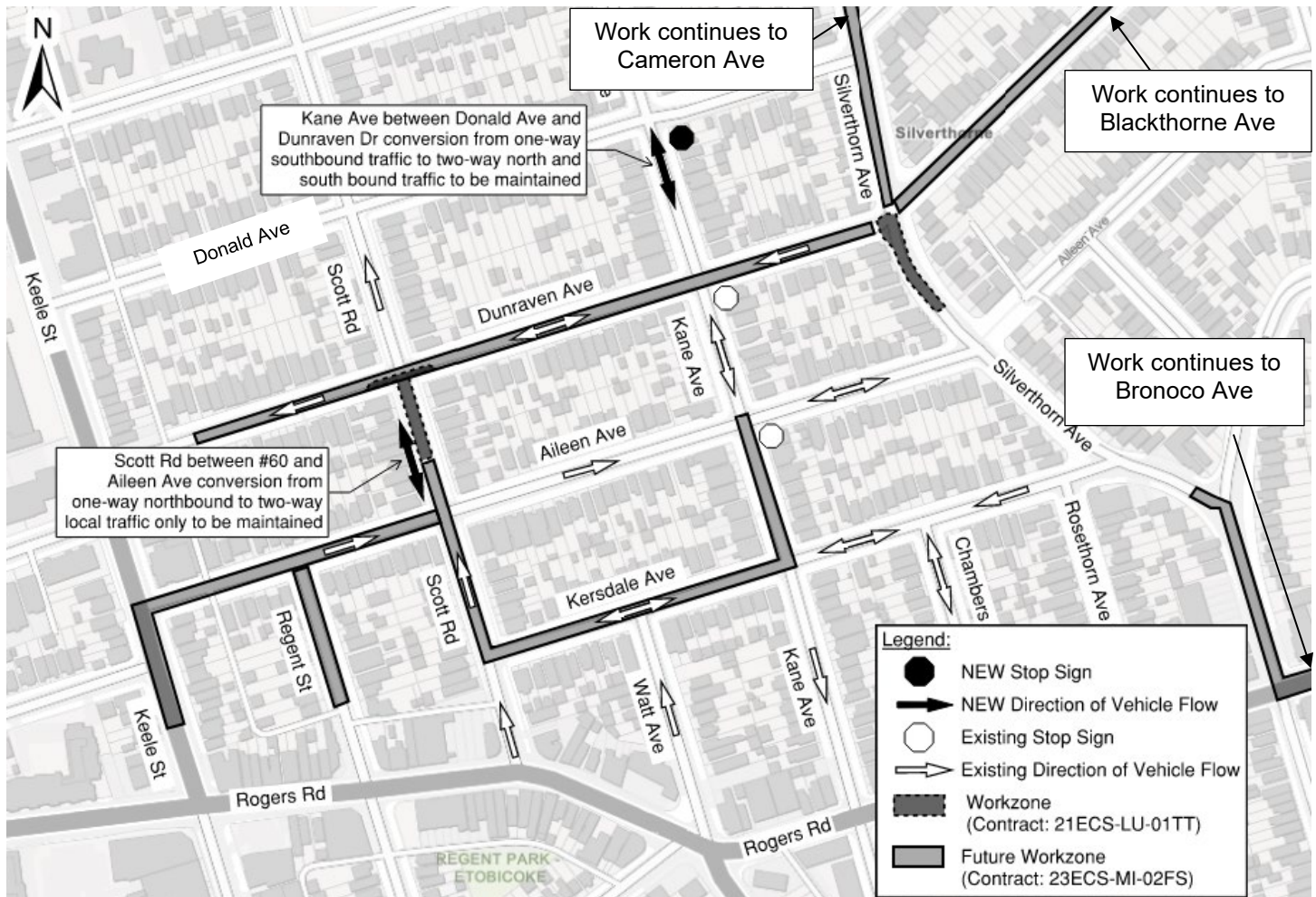
- Two-way directional traffic will be maintained on Kane Avenue between Donald Avenue and Dunraven Drive.
- Stop signs at Kane Avenue and Donald Avenue will remain in place.
- On-street parking is restricted on Kane Avenue between Dunraven Drive and Donald Avenue.

These temporary measures will be lifted once construction in the area is completed. The anticipated end date of the temporary measures is Summer 2027.

PLEASE NOTE: The map on the following page is for reference and to provide an overview of upcoming work only. **It is not indicative of the sequence or duration of the work.** Construction notices with further details will be issued approximately two weeks to one month prior to the beginning of any work. These notices will provide timelines, extensiveness, and boundaries of each work site.
