- 1. Sharaf Samhadana** (Report No. 7957)
Holder of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver Licence No. D01-5221523

DECISION:

The Tribunal finds as follows:

“Sharaf Samhadana’s Vehicle-For-Hire Driver Licence will be suspended for a period of six (6) months effective immediately subject to him providing written verification to Municipal Licensing and Standards (MLS) that he has successfully completed and benefitted from anger management counselling for a duration of at least six (6) hours, completed in sessions over a period of time, from a qualified counselling program or counsellor.

Upon providing this verification, Sharaf Samhadana or MLS can request that this matter be brought back to the Tribunal for a determination of the licensee’s fitness to maintain his licence.

While a licence is under suspension, the licence holder remains subject to all the normal responsibilities and obligations of a licence holder, including the payment of fees for any renewals that come due during the period of suspension.

Should the licence holder not produce the verification described above within six months of today’s date (or the next business day), the licence will be revoked.”

The Tribunal further ordered this matter is adjourned sine die, pending the outcome of the above order.
