TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE Ancaster Road Closed Between Wilson Avenue and Regent Road


The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the construction work at Ancaster Road, the road will be closed between Wilson Avenue and Regent Road effective from 7:00 a.m. on Monday, June 23, 2025, to Friday, July 4, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. for construction. This project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

WORK DETAILS

For this project, the contractor will:





- Excavate on Wilson Avenue between Lady York Avenue and Ancaster Road to install the sanitary sewer and restore the area.
- This work will require the temporary closure of the south end of Ancaster Road to all traffic.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p>Access for Local traffic only on Ancaster Road will be maintained at the Ancaster and Regent Road intersection. All traffic access is to be closed at the the Ancaster and Wilson Road intersection. Access to driveways on Ancaster Road will be maintained.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions; however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction. Pedestrian crossing at Wilson Avenue and Ancaster Road will be closed.</p>
	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
