Intersection Improvements at Deauville Lane and Grenoble Drive

Contract: 23ECS-RD-10SP

Expected Start Date: August 6, 2025 Expected End Date: End of August, 2025

This notice provides an update on the construction work at Deauville Lane and Grenoble Drive that will improve safety and connectivity for all road users. Planned changes include:

- Removing the right-turn channels to create shorter, more direct routes for pedestrians and cyclists.
- Widening sidewalks and enhancing green space with new trees, plantings, and seating areas.

The intersection of Deauville Lane and Grenoble Drive will be fully closed to vehicle traffic from August 6 to late August to carry out the work.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WORK DETAILS




The City’s contractor will:






- Remove the road surface and road base materials
- Relocate streetlights
- Re-align maintenance holes and stormwater catch basins
- Install a granular base and base asphalt
- Pave the road surface
- Install new trees and plantings
- Restore driveways and other areas impacted by construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

	<p>TTC Service: During this project there will be changes to TTC bus service. 34C Eglinton East (westbound) buses will divert via St. Dennis Drive, Don Mills Road, Gateway Boulevard, Grenoble Drive, and Spanbridge Road. 100 Flemington Park (both directions) buses will divert via Linkwood Lane and Spanbridge Road.</p> <div><p>This map shows the diversion for TTC Route 100.
