Comments	The terms of the Easement Transfer Agreement authorized by DAF 2023-299 provide at section 9 that the City is responsible for reimbursing the Owner for reasonable legal costs incurred in the negotiation and registration of the Temporary Easement. The Owner provided their legal invoices for review, and a reduction in fees was negotiated by staff for duplication of work and charges not compensable under the Expropriations Act. The Owner has agreed to accept payment of the fees noted above in the Financial Impact Section as the payment provided for costs in the Easement Transfer Agreement. The fees are considered reasonable and payable pursuant to the Easement Transfer Agreement and section 32 of the Expropriations Act.				
	The Easement Transfer Agreement is without prejudice to the Owner's right to pursue additional claims under the Expropriations Act.

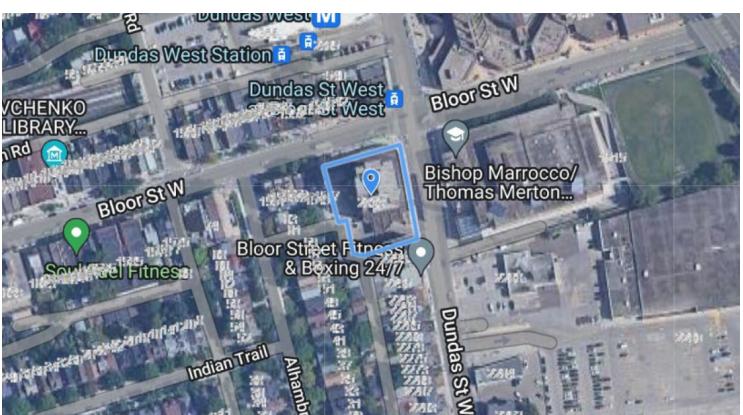
