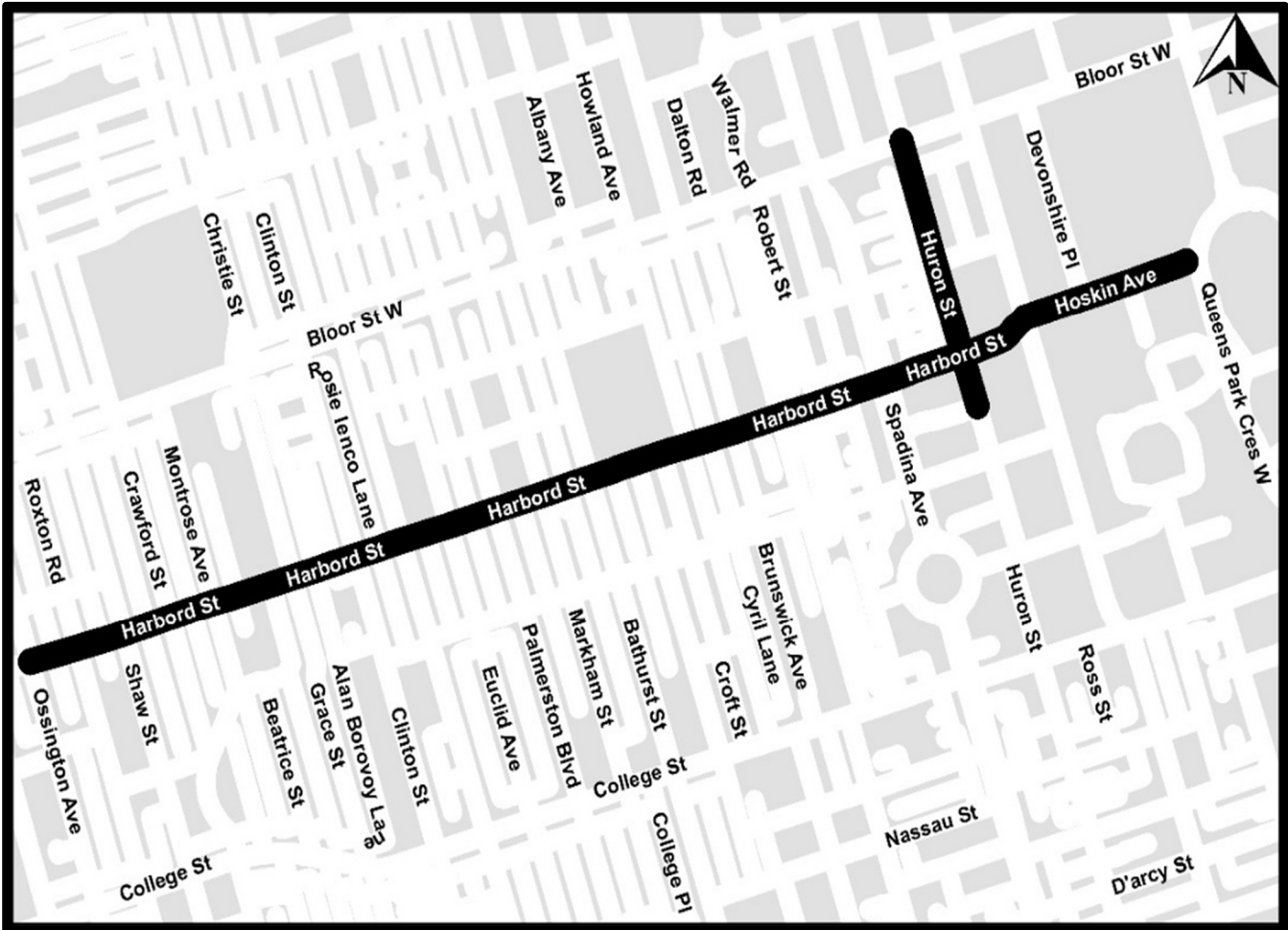

Harbord Street	from Grace Street to St. George Street
Huron Street	from Bloor Street West to Classic Avenue
SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT	
Harbord Street	from Spadina Avenue to St. George Street
ROAD RESURFACING AND BIKEWAY INSTALLATION	
Harbord Street	from Ossington Avenue to St. George Street
Hoskin Avenue	from St. George Street to Queen's Park Crescent

We know this project has an impact on all businesses and residences within the project area. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing, and other inconveniences while we work to complete this City infrastructure project.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

To date the City's contractor has completed:

- Watermain and water service replacement on Harbord Street from Grace Street to St. George Street.
- Watermain and water service replacement on Huron Street from Bloor Street West to Harbord Street.
- Sanitary sewer and sewer service replacement on Harbord Street from Spadina Avenue to St. George Street.
- Temporary restoration.

REMAINING WORK

The City’s contractor will:

- Resurface the road, including repairs to sidewalks, crosswalks and curbs on Harbord Street Hoskin Avenue, and Huron Street.
- Install raised bike/bus platforms on Harbord Street and Hoskin Avenue.
- Modify traffic signals on Harbord Street at Ossington Avenue and St. George Street.
- Construct a physically protected bikeway on Harbord Street and Hoskin Avenue.
- Construct bulb-outs and curb islands for planting and green infrastructure on Harbord Street and Hoskin Avenue.
