# Basement Flooding Protection Program Sidewalk and Restoration on Westgate Boulevard

Contract: 21ECS-LU-04FP
Start Date: June 30, 2025 Expected End Date: August 8, 2025

\*Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on the new sidewalk installation and the restoration timeline of Westgate Boulevard from Armour Boulevard to the Westgate Boulevard culd-de-sac as well as the Westgate Ravine trail. Please see the construction map below.

#### **WORK STATUS**

Contract 23ECS-LU-05FP for the Westgate Ravine is nearing completion, with the contractor scheduled to demobilize from the site in June, 2025.

Following this, the Contract 21ECS-LU-04FP contractor will return to the site to install curbs, gutters, and sidewalks, reconstruct the road, and complete landscaping restoration on Westgate Boulevard between Armour Boulevard and the Westgate Boulevard cul-de-sac. The contractor will also restore the Westgate Ravine trail impacted by construction.

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#### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Full restoration of Westgate Boulevard including installation of curbs and sidewalks, permanent road reconstruction from curb-to-curb, and restoration of landscaping and driveways.



**Work Hours**: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



**Traffic Management**: When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.

Roadway access may be temporarily affected during curb restoration, sidewalk installation, or driveway/roadway reconstruction activities performed by the contractor. Should a road closure be necessary to carry out the work, you will be notified in advance and provided with instructions regarding vehicle relocation.



**Road and Sidewalk Access:** In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

**Driveway Access:** The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Driveway access may be temporarily affected during curb restoration, sidewalk installation, or driveway/roadway reconstruction activities performed by the contractor.



**Pedestrians:** The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.



**People Cycling:** Cyclists traveling on Westgate Boulevard from the Westgate Cul-de-sac to Armour Boulevard are required to dismount and walk their bicycles, accompanied by a contractor site representative, to safely cross the work zone.



**Parking:** This project affects on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.



Parking Violation Notices: Please ensure that you park in a legal parking spot at all times. If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, do the following within 15 days of the notice date:

- 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the yellow ticket)
- 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City, online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the yellow ticket). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction.

Please note: Parking violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (e.g., in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).



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**Accessible Accommodation:** The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
