

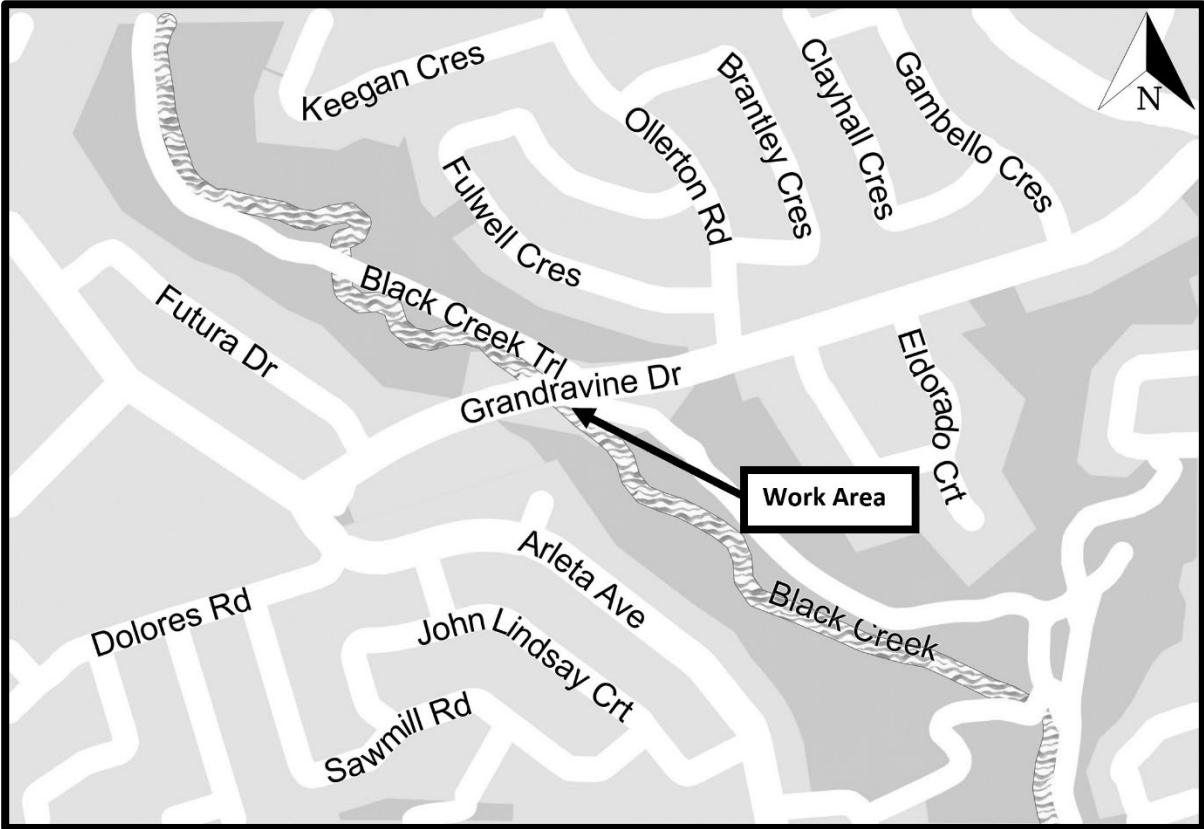

## Grandravine Drive Culvert Replacement over Black Creek

Contract: 24ECS-BE-07PM  
Start Date: June 2025   End Date: May 2026  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto will replace the Grandravine Drive culvert over Black Creek. This work will ensure that the culvert meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program.

### WORK DETAILS

- The City’s contractor will:
- Earth excavate and backfill.
  - Remove and replace the existing corrugated steel pipe arch culvert with twin precast concrete culvert units, and waterproofing.
  - Reconstruct culvert inlet and outlet.
  - Reconstruct retaining walls.
  - Reconstruct guide rails.
  - Reconstruct the sidewalk, boulevard, asphalt pavement within the proposed work area.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
	<b>Pre-Construction Inspection:</b> Bronte Construction Inc., under contract to the City of Toronto, is conducting inspections of properties in the vicinity of the

	<p>construction area before construction starts. Affected properties will receive a separate notice to set up an appointment for the inspection.</p> <p>The inspection will look at the exterior and interior of properties to verify existing conditions. Although participation is voluntary, the City encourages all property owners to participate. Without the survey, it will be difficult to confirm any claims of damage caused by construction. All inspection staff will wear photo I.D. and carry photo equipment for this work.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Grandravine Drive will be fully closed for vehicular traffic at the culvert location for the duration of the project.</li><li>• No through traffic will be permitted for motor vehicles.</li><li>• A temporary pedestrian bridge will be provided to ensure continuous and safe pedestrian access across the construction area.</li><li>• Pedestrians are advised to utilize the designated temporary bridge and adhere to posted signage for safe navigation.</li><li>• Motorists are encouraged to follow detour signs for alternative road access.</li></ul>
	<p><b>On-Site Communication:</b> There are times when contractors need to communicate with homeowners about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access, water shut offs, pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility company branded clothing. If you need to speak with staff on the construction site, please ask for the Site Inspector.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
