Doris Avenue Extension Archaeological Investigation Work

The City of Toronto is advancing the Doris Avenue Extension project, connecting Doris Avenue and Tradewind Avenue south of Anndale Avenue, following the recommendations of the completed North York Centre South Service Road Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Addendum (EAA).

To support the detailed design process, field investigations are currently underway. City contractors will dig small test pits in front of your property to help evaluate the archaeological potential of the area. **All work will take place on City-owned property**, which may include the area between your property and the sidewalk.




More details about the design process and opportunities for public input will be shared through future notices ahead of construction, which could begin as early as 2027. To learn more about the project, visit toronto.ca/DorisExtension.

SITE INVESTIGATION WORK DETAILS

Site work crews will dig small test pits (about 30 cm x 30 cm) within the City-owned portion of a property to check for any items of archaeological significance prior to construction activities. This work will be performed under the guidance of a licensed archaeologist. All test pits will be carefully filled in, and the area will be restored to its original condition after the work is done.


WHAT TO EXPECT DURING SITE WORK

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Work Hours: Site work will typically occur Monday to Friday between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
	Traffic Management: The site work may result in temporary disruption to local traffic. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and vehicle traffic restrictions will be necessary.
	Restoration: All areas affected by the site work will be restored when work is complete.
