

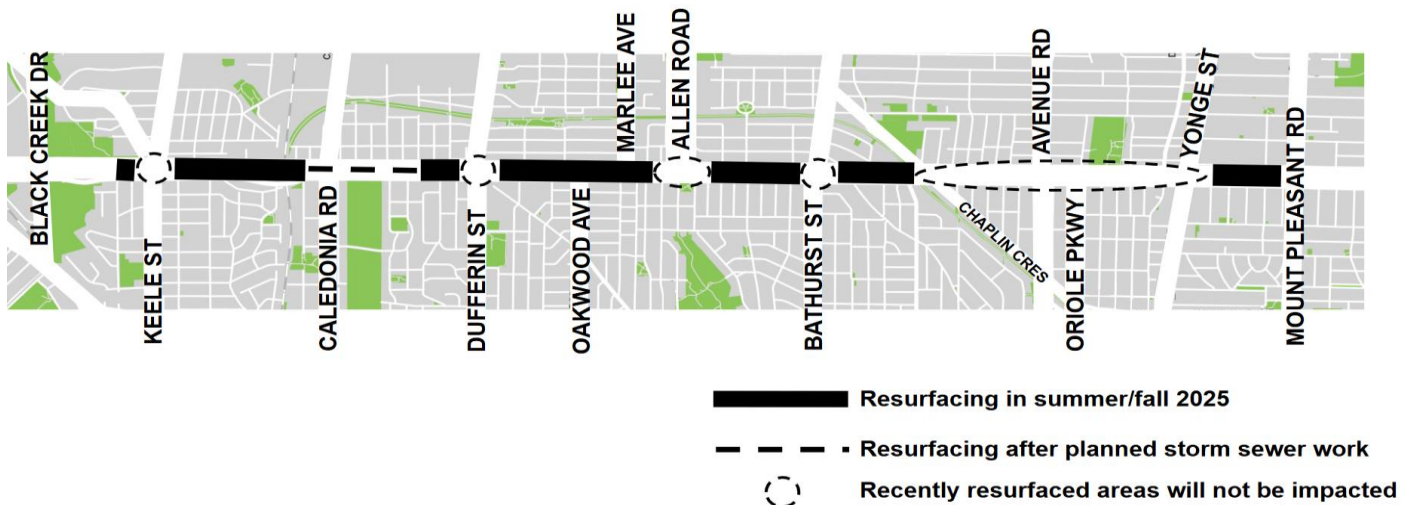

Road Repair and Resurfacing of Eglinton Avenue from Bicknell Avenue to Mount Pleasant Road

Start Date: September 2025 | End Date: October 2025 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is preparing to resurface the roadway on Eglinton Avenue between Bicknell Avenue (west of Keele Street) and Mount Pleasant Road. The main resurfacing work will happen overnight to minimize the impact on traffic. During the day some localized project work will continue with efforts to maintain all travel lanes open as much as possible. Night work in each area will be limited to a few nights.

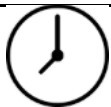
Some TTC stops and traffic signal pole locations are changing to prepare for a future condition after the Eglinton Crosstown LRT is operational. Travel lanes will remain in their current configuration after the resurfacing is complete.



What to Expect During Construction








Resurfacing will begin near Keele Street and progress eastward. The segment between Caledonia Road and Harvey Avenue will be resurfaced following planned storm sewer work.

The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts of noise and other inconveniences. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained and there will be no changes to emergency services.



Work hours: The main resurfacing work will happen at night, from 8pm to 6am to minimize impact to traffic on the corridor. Night work in each area will be limited to a few nights. During the day some localized project work will continue with efforts to maintain all travel lanes open as much as possible.

	<p>Traffic management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic for everyone's safety. Please expect delays.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Road and sidewalk access: There may be temporary partial or full road and sidewalk closures in order to complete the work safely. • Driveway access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open.
	<p>People cycling: Please share the traffic lane in the active work zones or dismount and walk your bicycle along the sidewalk.</p>
	<p>Transit: Bus service will continue but some bus stop locations will change. Please visit ttc.ca for more information about bus stop changes.</p>
	<p>Parking and loading: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects installation, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Parking Violation Notices: <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.</u> If you receive a yellow ticket during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date in order to avoid additional fines: 1) Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the yellow parking violation notice) <u>or</u> 2) File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the yellow parking violation notice). As part of the dispute process, you may submit a copy of this notice</p>
	<p>Garbage & recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that your bins are labelled with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Accessible accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during installation. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, please inform the contact listed below.</p>
