Installation of Road Safety Improvements and Bikeways from Cosburn Avenue to Danforth Avenue

Start Date: September 2, 2025 End Date: September 5, 2025

**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City is installing road safety improvements from Cosburn Avenue to Danforth Avenue. The installation will include a contra-flow bicycle lane on Logan Avenue from Cosburn Avenue to Gowan Avenue which allows people cycling to travel in two directions on a one-way street and will facilitate passage to Carlaw Avenue for people cycling southbound. For this one block, parking will move permanently to the east side of the street.

Shared lane markings or “sharrows” will indicate a shared environment for people on bicycles and motor vehicles. They will be added on Logan Avenue northbound, on Gowan Avenue in both directions, and on Carlaw Avenue southbound. There is no impact to parking.

The City will continue to review options for cycling connections between Danforth Avenue and Cosburn Avenue.

The installation will include:

Logan Avenue

- New southbound contra-flow bike lane on the west side of Logan Avenue between Gowan Avenue and Cosburn Avenue.
- On-street parking on Logan Avenue between Gowan Avenue and Cosburn Avenue will shift to the east side of the street with an increase of 3 parking spaces.
- Shared lane markings (sharrows) on Logan Avenue from Danforth Avenue to Gowan Avenue
- New all-way stop:
 - Logan Avenue and Floyd Avenue
 - Logan Avenue and Gowan Avenue (for people cycling southbound)

Carlaw Avenue

- Shared lane markings (sharrows) on Carlaw Avenue from Gowan Avenue to Danforth Avenue
- New all-way stop at Mortimer Avenue and Carlaw Avenue

Gowan Avenue

- Shared lane markings (sharrows) on Gowan Avenue Gowan Avenue from Logan Avenue to Carlaw Avenue

Additional Safety Improvements









- In-road flexible speed signs on Mortimer Avenue between Pape Avenue and Carlaw Avenue to indicate the 30km/h speed limit
- New and refreshed pavement markings at pedestrian crossings

What to Expect During Installation

The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts of noise and other inconveniences. We appreciate your patience.

During installation, the City’s contractors will:

- Temporarily suspend on-street parking on Logan Avenue between Cosburn Avenue and Gowan Avenue for 24 hours to install contra-flow pavement markings
- Remove existing pavement markings and install new markings
- Install new signage, as required

	Work Hours: Pavement marking changes will take place overnight from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Daytime work will take place mostly in the off-peak hours/evenings to limit traffic disruptions.
 	Traffic Management: No significant delays are expected during construction. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be partial or full road and sidewalk closures within the work zone.• Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.• Emergency Services: Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	People Cycling: During construction, areas of the road may be temporarily closed through the work zone. Signs will be posted directing cyclists and drivers to share the lane, single file, through the work zone.
	Parking and Loading: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects installation, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner . If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222 . Changes to the parking by-laws will be signed.
	Parking Violation Notices: <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers will issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date in order to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the yellow parking violation notice) or2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the yellow parking violation notice). As part of the dispute process, you may submit a copy of this notice. Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones). In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.
	Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i>
	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during installation. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, please inform the contact listed below.
