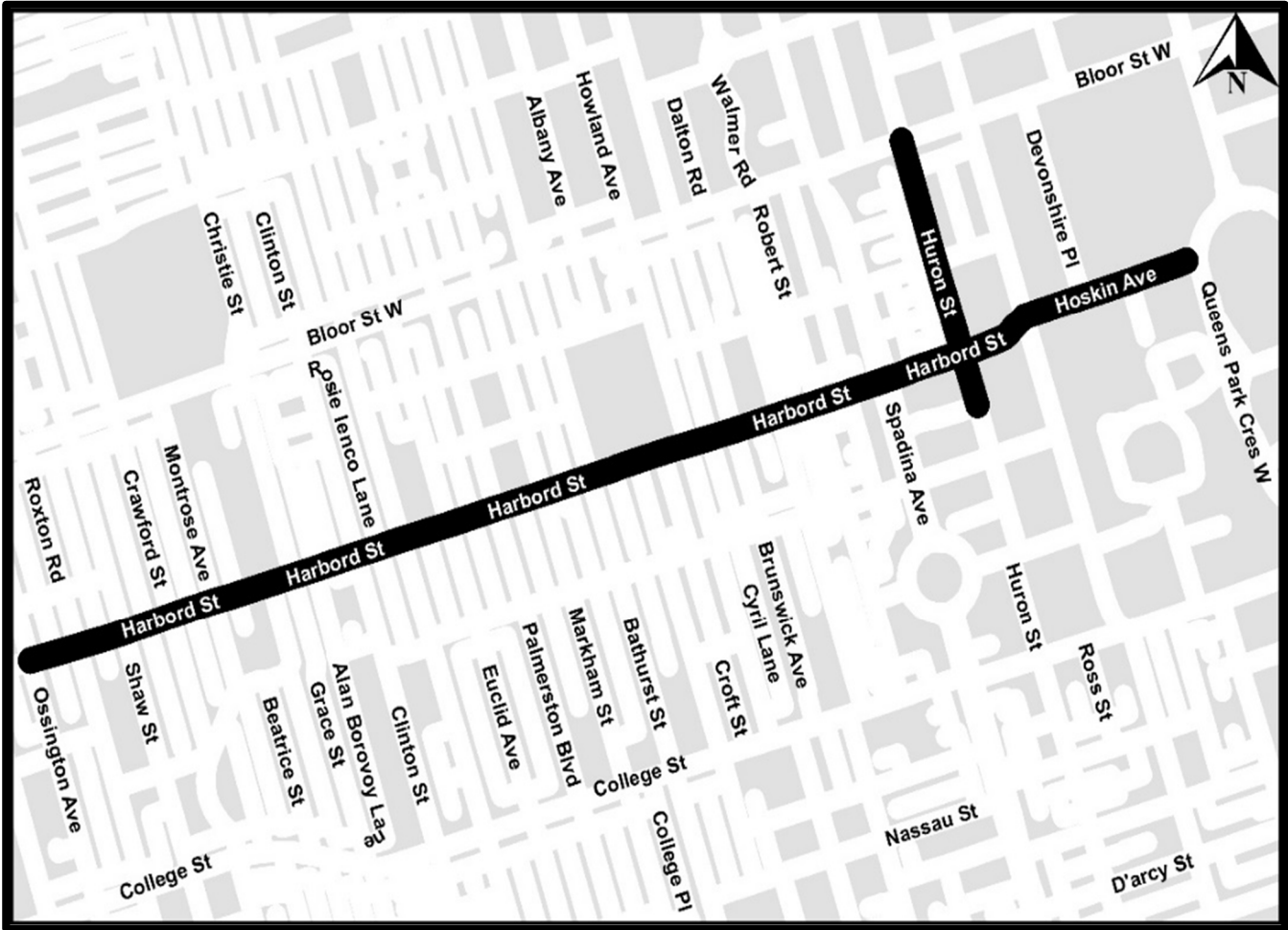

Harbord Street	from Grace Street to St. George Street	Completed
Huron Street	from Bloor Street West to Classic Avenue	Completed
Phase 2: SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT		Status
Harbord Street	from Spadina Avenue to St. George Street	Completed
Phase 3 (Final): ROAD RESURFACING AND BIKEWAY INSTALLATION		Status
Harbord Street	from Ossington Avenue to Grace Street	Work will commence the week of September 1, 2025, and is expected to be completed by late November 2025
Harbord Street	from Grace Street to Bathurst Street	Expected to be completed by early October 2025
Harbord Street	from Bathurst Street to Spadina Avenue	Expected to be completed by early October 2025
Harbord Street	from Spadina Avenue to St. George Street	Expected to be completed by early October 2025
Hoskin Avenue	from St. George Street to Queen’s Park Crescent	Expected to be completed by early October 2025

Periodic short-term road closures will be required to complete final works. Advance notice will be distributed to local properties prior to these closures.

REMAINING WORK

- The City’s contractor will:
- Pave base and top asphalt on Harbord Street from Grace Street to St. George Street and Hoskin Avenue.
 - Pave base and top asphalt, including repairs to sidewalks, and crosswalks on Harbord Street from Grace Steet to Ossington Avenue.
 - Install raised bike/bus platforms and curbs on Harbord Street from Grace Street to Ossington Avenue and Hoskin Avenue.
 - Modify traffic signals on Harbord Street at Ossington Avenue and St. George Street.
 - Construct a physically protected bikeway on Harbord Street and Hoskin Avenue.
 - Construct bulb-outs and curb islands for planting and green infrastructure on Harbord Street and Hoskin Avenue.
