Installation of Traffic Control Measures on Islington Avenue

from Gosfield Gate to Barker Street

Contract: 23ECS-LU-10FP Start Date: August 5, 2025 End Date: August 6, 2025 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. Construction work on Islington Avenue is about to commence. During initial construction the contractor will be installing traffic control measures on Islington Avenue from Gosfield Gate to Barker Street to facilitate the construction of the storm sewers on Islington Avenue. These traffic control measures are being undertaken at night to minimize daytime traffic disruptions. This nighttime construction work will occur on Tuesday, August 5, 2025, beginning at 7:00 p.m. until Wednesday, August 6, 2025, at 1:00 a.m.

The Contractor is permitted to work 24 hours a day until the work can be completed and then open the roadway to traffic; however, a minimum of one lane in each direction will always be maintained.

Regular work hours will resume when this overnight work is complete.

Your patience and understanding are appreciated during this disruption.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

 You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.



Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be always maintained.

Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be always kept open.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 p.m. on Tuesday, August 5, 2025, to 1:00 a.m., on Wednesday, August 6, 2025.

Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible.
