over Humber River

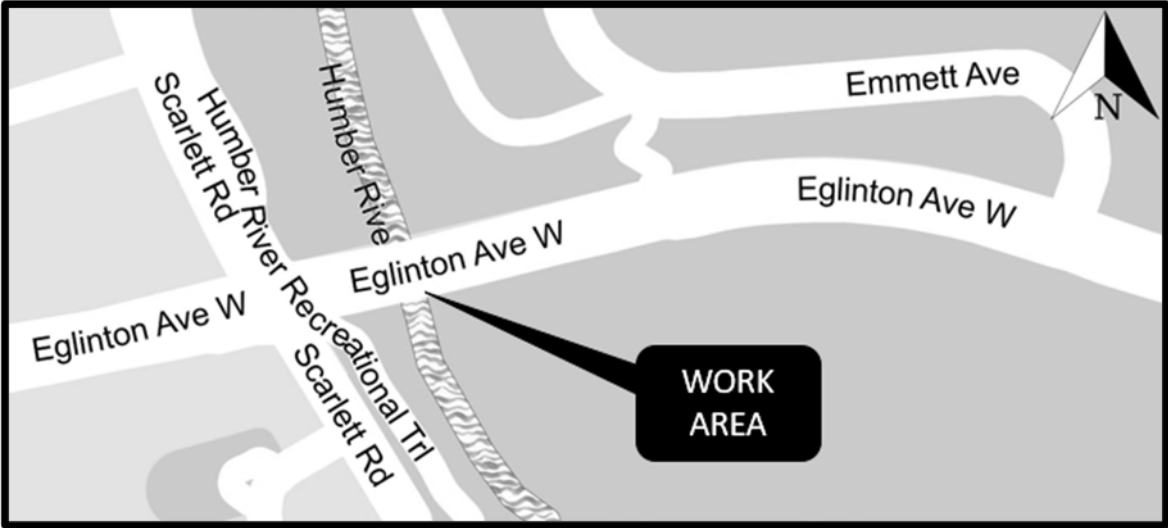

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the underside of the Eglinton Ave West Bridge over Humber River. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

- The City’s contractor will:
- Repair and refurbish the piers underneath the bridge.
  - Patch repair the bridge deck soffit near the abutments.
  - Provide access to the work areas and implement protection for the environment while the work is carried out.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and occasional overnight work where required</p>
	<p><b>Pedestrian Pathway Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be pedestrian pathway restrictions within the work zone underneath the bridge. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the <b>Project Manager</b> listed below.</p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
