Gardiner Expressway Strategic Rehabilitation: Section 3 Early Works on Five Bridges

Gardiner Expressway Overnight Lane Reductions at Park Lawn Road - August 28 - 29,

Starting at 11 p.m. on Thursday, August 28 until 5 a.m. on Friday, August 29, the Gardiner Expressway eastbound lanes at Parklawn Road will be reduced to two lanes for the **installation of girders** (large beams that support the elevated roadway). The westbound lanes will not be impacted.

There will also be intermittent stoppages to northbound and southbound traffic on Park Lawn Road between the westbound Gardiner Expressway on-ramp and the eastbound off-ramp.

Gardiner Expressway Overnight Lane Reductions at Mimico Creek - September 2 - 6,

From Tuesday, September 2 to Friday, September 6, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly, the Gardiner Expressway eastbound lanes will be reduced to two lanes to facilitate the **removal of girders**. Two eastbound lanes will be maintained, and the westbound lanes will not be impacted.

Both installation and demolition work are being completed overnight when traffic volumes are lower to help ensure the safety of crews and the travelling public.
