Purpose	To obtain authority to enter into a lease extension and amending agreement (the " <b>Lease Extension Agreement</b> ") with 2643413 Ontario Inc. (the " <b>Tenant</b> ") with respect to the property municipally known as 705 Progress Avenue, Unit 33, Toronto, for the purpose of wholesale and export of frozen, fresh or live seafood.								
Property	Part of the property municipally known as 705 Progress Avenue, Toronto, as shown on the Location Map and premises sketches attached in Appendix "B" (the "Property"), comprising of approximately 5,072 square feet and known as Unit 33 (the "Premises").								
Actions	1. Authority be granted to enter into a three (3) year Lease Extension Agreement with the Tenant, substantially on the major terms and conditions set out in Appendix "A", and including such other terms as deemed appropriate by the approving authority herein, and in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor.								
Financial Impact	705 Progress Avenue is a facility jointly owned by the City of Toronto (the "City") and the Toronto District School Board (collectively, the "Landlord"). Net revenues collected are divided equally between the parties. The City's portion of total revenues is \$129,336.00 (plus HST), based on the total minimum rent of \$258,672.00 (plus HST), for the period of thirty-six (36) months commencing October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2028, as per the below table. The City's net revenue will be transferred to the dedicated parkland reserve fund (5% and 2% Land Acquisition Reserve Fund Scarborough - XR2007) less the management fee to be directed to the 2025 Approved Operating Budget for Corporate Real Estate Management ("CREM"), under cost center FA1378 and will be included in future operating budget submissions for Council consideration.

	The Tenant is responsible for the proportionate share of realty taxes, building insurance and maintenance, as well as all other operating costs of the building, including water, gas, hydro, heating and air conditioning.								
	The Chief Financial Officer has reviewed this DAF and agrees with the financial impact information.								
Comments	By a lease agreement dated December 12, 2022 (the " <b>Lease</b> "), the Landlord leased the Premises to the Tenant for a term of three (3) years, commencing on October 1, 2022, and ending on September 30, 2025 (see Delegated Approva Form 2022-240). Authority is now being sought to extend the term of the Lease for a further period of three (3) years and to amend certain terms of the Lease.								
	705 Progress Avenue is an industrial mall type property consisting of approximately 156,000 square feet acquired in August 1996 by the former City of Scarborough in partnership with the former Scarborough Board of Education (the "Board"). Pending development of the property as a future park and a school facility, it was decided to continue leasing the units to multiple tenants. The former City of Scarborough and the Board entered into an Operating Agreement dated January 2, 1997, which provided that the City, in consultation with the Board, would engage a property manager (currently Compass Commercial Realty LP) and enter into a management agreement. The City and the property manager would be responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Property.								
	The proposed minimum rent and other major terms and conditions of the Lease Extension Agreement are considered to be fair, reasonable and reflective of market rates.

## **Major Terms and Conditions**

Minimum Rent: October 1, 2025 – September 30, 2026 \$83,688.00 net of HST (\$16.50/ft2)

October 1, 2026 – September 30, 2027 \$86,224.00 net of HST (\$17.00/ft2)
October 1, 2027 – September 30, 2028 \$88,760.00 net of HST (\$17.50/ft2)

Additional Rent: Estimated \$8,267.36, plus any applicable taxes based on the 2025 operating cost budget rate

of \$6.52/ ft<sup>2</sup>.

**Area of Premises:** Approximately 5,072 ft<sup>2</sup>.

Extended Term: Three (3) years (October 1, 2025 – September 30, 2028).

Prepaid Rent: Last month's Rent = \$11,472.27 ((\$17.50+6.52) x 5,072 SF/12 +HST)

**Security Deposit:** \$11,472.27 ((\$17.50+6.52) x 5,072 SF/12 +HST)

**Landlord's Early Termination** Notice period under Section 15.4 amended from six (6) months to three (3) months.
