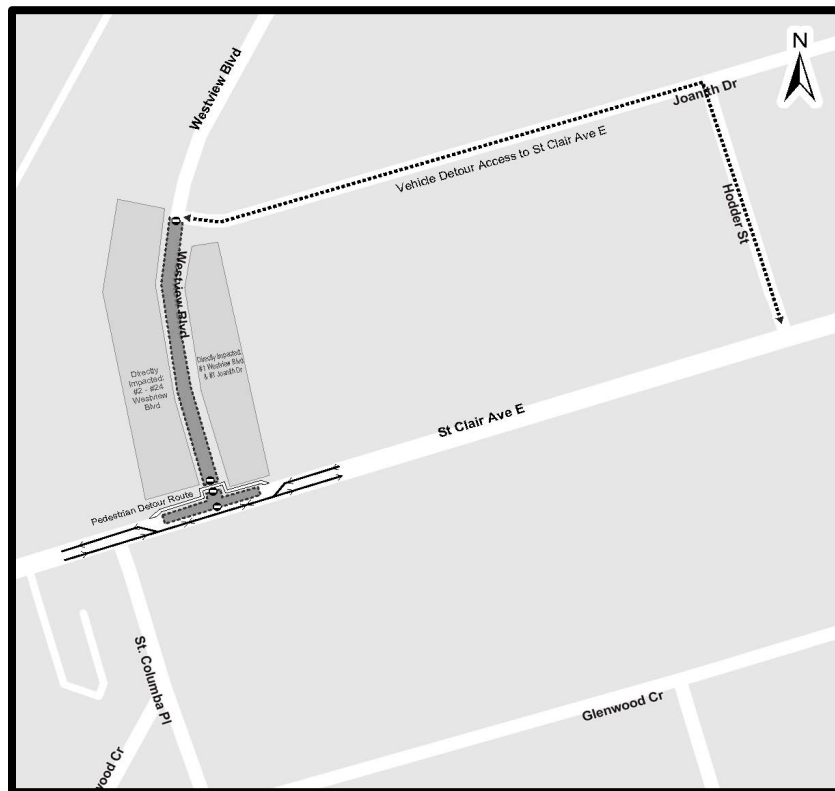

This notice is to provide an update on the work happening at the intersection of Westview Boulevard and St. Clair Avenue East. Due to the depth and nature of the construction work, the road closure will be extended until **7:00 p.m. on Friday, September 26, 2025.**

WORK DETAILS

- This work will require a temporary closure at the intersection of St. Clair Avenue East and a portion of Westview Boulevard, south of Joanith Drive, to all traffic.
- Some residents living on Westview Boulevard will not have access to their driveways during the

construction period. The contractor will distribute Driveway Access Notices to those homes impacted by construction.

- The closure will impact St. Clair Avenue East and Westview Boulevard. Joanith Drive and Hodder Street will remain open and available for vehicle detour to St. Clair Avenue East.

|  | Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. |
|  | Pedestrians: The work will require temporary sidewalk restrictions. However, pedestrian detour access will always be available during construction. |
|  | Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Saturday, with additional after hours work as required. |
|  | Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below. |
