**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on September 17, 2025, as follows:

“The Motorized Refreshment Vehicle licences shall be subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The Motorized Refreshment Vehicle licences will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years, commencing on September 18, 2025. Zaen Inc. is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Zaen Inc. and its directors and officers, and conduct other investigations as appropriate, to assess Zaen Inc. and its directors and officers' compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (2) During the probationary period, if MLS has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Zaen Inc., or any other concerns with respect to Zaen Inc.'s conduct, or the conduct of its directors and officers, those matters and Report No. 8010 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.”
