

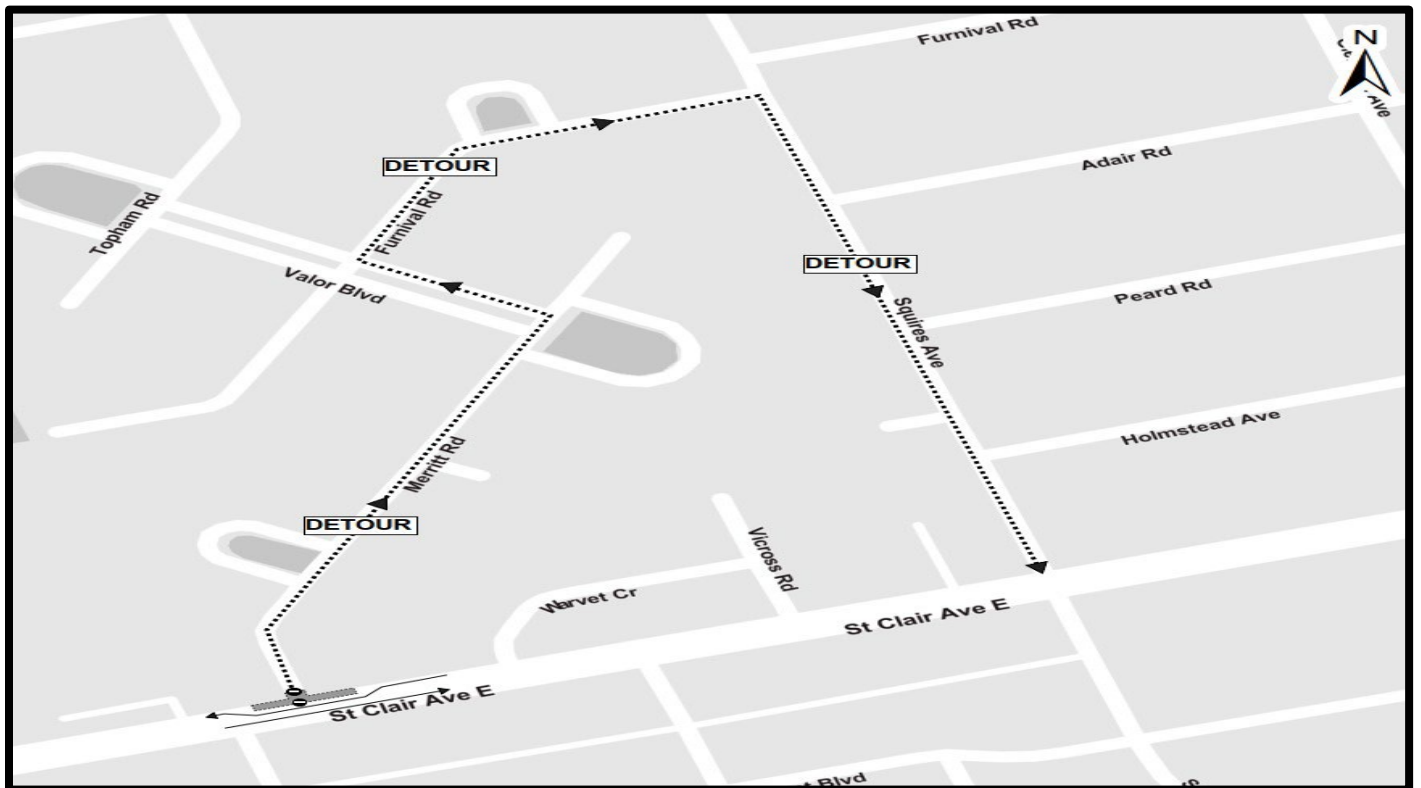

Sanitary Sewer Upgrade on Merritt Road

Contract: 23ECS-LU-03FP
Expected Start Date: September 2, 2025
Expected End Date: September 5, 2025

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the sanitary sewer system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the construction work, **the road will be closed at the intersection of St. Clair Avenue East and Merritt Road effective from 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 2, 2025, to 11:00 p.m. on Friday, September 5, 2025.**

WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Excavate on St. Clair Avenue East and Merritt Road
- Install the sanitary sewer tie-in and restore the area.
- This work will require a temporary closure at the intersection of St. Clair Avenue East and Merritt Road.
- The intersection closure will limit all access from Merritt Road onto St. Clair Avenue East.
- To access St. Clair Ave East from Merritt Boulevard please detour through Valor Boulevard to Furnival Road to Squires Avenue to St. Clair Avenue East.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise, and traffic delays.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Please note the traffic detour plan listed in the Work Details section of this Construction Notice.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The work will require temporary sidewalk restrictions. However, pedestrian detour access will always be available during construction.</p>
	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Tuesday, September 2, 2025, to Friday, September 5, 2025.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
