Approved pursuant to the Delegated Authority contained in Article 2 of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 213, Real Property Prepared By: **Boluwarin Moieed** Division: Corporate Real Estate Management Date Prepared: September 2, 2025 Phone No.: 437-996-8720 **Purpose** To obtain authority to amend Delegated Approval Form No. 2025-029 ("DAF 2025-029"), to amend the financial impact regarding a lease extension amending agreement ("Agreement") with His Majesty the King in right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Infrastructure (the "Landlord"), for the City's continued use of the building located at 354 George Street, Toronto, for the purpose of a temporary shelter (the "Revised Lease Extension Agreement"). The property located at 354 George Street, Toronto (parking lot and building) comprising a rentable area of 23,810 **Property** square feet, which comprise of 19,325 square feet for certain premises in the building and 4,485 square feet for the 19 parking spaces, as shown on the Location Map in Appendix "A" (the "Leased Premises"). **Actions** Authority be granted to enter into the Revised Lease Extension Agreement on the terms as set out in DAF 2025-029 and on the amended terms set out herein. **Financial Impact** The total cost to the City for the two-year extension term is \$746,299.00 (plus HST) or \$759,433.86 (net of HST recovery) with an additional \$101,078.71 (net of HST recovery) in additional rent from the total amount set out in DAF 2025-029. The Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer has reviewed this DAF and agrees with the financial implications as detailed in the Financial Impact section. Comments Pursuant to the approval of DAF 2025-029, the City was authorized to enter into an Agreement with the Landlord, retroactive to May 1, 2025. Following execution by both parties, the Landlord identified an error on their part regarding the additional rent charged to the City, which increased from \$2.67/sq. ft. to \$5.24/sq. ft. Accordingly, an amendment to DAF 2025-029 is required to facilitate execution of the Revised Lease Extension Agreement. TSSS has approved and confirmed that the said terms and conditions are fair, reasonable and meet their service needs.
