This notice provides an update on the planned watermain replacement, road resurfacing and sidewalk replacement work scheduled to start on September 18 2025. Construction for this project will be completed in four stages starting at Queen Street W.

Watermain replacement is scheduled to start at the south end of Sorauren Avenue near to Virtue Street. Please see the construction stages and anticipated timeline with parking impacts for each stage of work below.

Construction Timeline

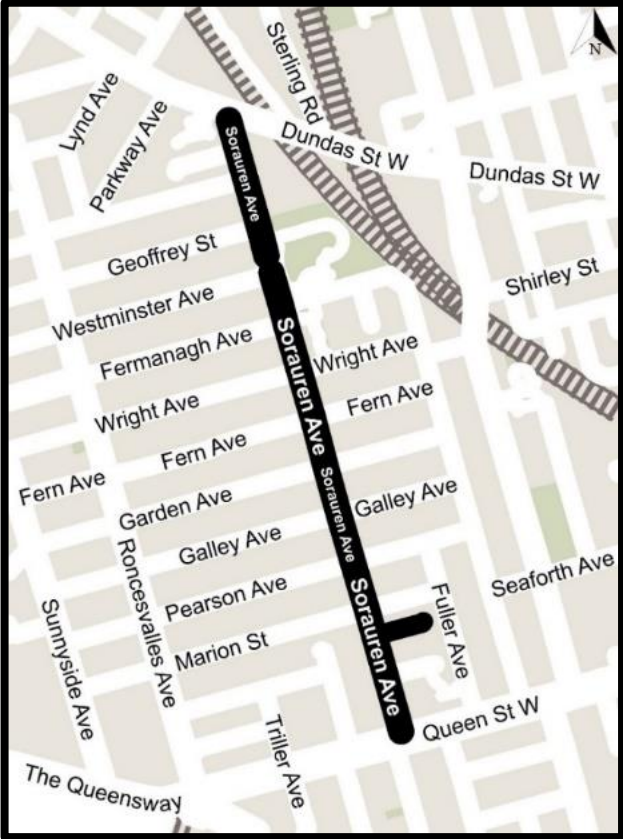

Stage 1 Sept – Dec 2025	Queen St - Pearson Ave	Watermain Removal	No on street parking during construction times. 7am -7pm Access to on street parking will be reopened in the evening
Stage 2 Sept – Dec 2025	Pearson Ave - Wright St	Watermain Replacement	No on street parking during construction times. 7am -7pm Access to on street parking will be reopened in the evening
Stage 3 Feb 2026	Wright Street to Geofrey St	Sidewalk Repair /Replacement	During sidewalk construction pedestrian traffic will be directed to the adjacent sidewalk which will remain open.
Stage 4 March - April 2025	Geofrey St to Dundas St W	Road resurfacing / area restoration	No on street parking during construction times. 7am -7pm Access to on street parking will be reopened in the evening

As the first two stages of watermain construction moves north on Souraren Avenue, our contractor will reopen each stage location after major work has been completed. During stages 3 and 4 our contractor will proceed with sidewalk repair, road resurfacing and final restorations.

Traffic/Parking during Construction







During construction traffic on Sorauren Avenue will be reduced to one lane with traffic personnel. On street parking on Souraren Avenue will be restricted daily during construction hours from 7am to 7pm.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• During construction traffic on Sorauren Avenue will be reduced to one lane with traffic personnel.
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions; however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p>People Cycling: Travel will be reduced to one shared lane in each direction for people cycling and driving through the work zone.</p>
	<p>Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>

	Additional information regarding on street parking during construction will be provided in the next construction update
	<p>Parking Violation Notice: <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction. <p>If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy. Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (e.g. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones). In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
