## Basement Flooding Protection Program Test Pits for Soil Sampling

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. As part of this work, investigative test pits will be performed to collect soil samples in preparation for future phases (3 and 4) of the project. Soil Sampling will take place on Thursday, September 25, 2025, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.


### WORK DETAILS




For this project, the contractor will conduct Test Pits for Soil Sampling on the following streets:

- Furnival Road
- Glenburn Avenue
- Merritt Road
- Peard Road
- Squires Avenue
- Squires Court
- Topham Road
- Valour Boulevard

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- This is a one-day operation with minimal impact on residents.
- Test pit sampling is anticipated to take a maximum of one hour at each location.

	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Traffic on each street will be reduced to one lane. One lane of traffic will have to yield to oncoming traffic.</li> </ul>

	<b>Pedestrians:</b> Sidewalks will be fully maintained and accessible.
	<b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., on Thursday, September 25, 2025.
	<b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
