

Sanitary Sewer Upgrade on Merritt Road

The purpose of this notice is to provide an update on the work happening at the intersection of Merritt Road and St. Clair Avenue East. Due to the depth and nature of the construction work, the road closure will be **extended to 11:00 p.m. on Friday, September 12, 2025**.

Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Please note the traffic detour plan listed in the map section of this Construction Notice.



Pedestrians: The work will require temporary sidewalk restrictions. However, pedestrian detour access will always be available during construction.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Tuesday, September 2, 2025, to Friday, September 12, 2025.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
