35 Bellevue Ave. Community Bulletin – October 31, 2025

Construction continues at 35 Bellevue Ave. Over the next two weeks (October 31 – November 14), residents can expect the following activities to take place:

Foundation Work

Work continues to build trench footings, piers, and foundation walls. This includes:

- Setting formwork, concrete pours, and reinforcing steel.
- Bringing a material spreader onsite to fill the voids within the foundation and prepare for the slab to be poured
- Pouring the concrete slab
- Impacts: moderate to loud noise, increased truck traffic, dust, and light to moderate vibration.
- Measures: work restricted to normal hours, dust control, and traffic management.

Backfilling

Work continues to backfill around the foundation perimeter and in the courtyard around the concrete slab using a mini-excavator and a handheld compaction machine.

• Impacts: Expect light to moderate vibration

Looking Ahead

Starting in November, deliveries of building modules will take place through February 2026.

Each delivery involves a truck entering the site, offloading materials, and then reversing out with the support of a traffic flagger. Neighbours will hear safety back up beepers when trucks reverse.

Residents can expect approximately one delivery per day, five days a week. Delivery trucks will range in size from 40 to 53 feet in length.



How Vibration is Measured

Construction vibration is measured in millimetres per second (mm/s) using Peak Particle Velocity (PPV).

Description	Approximate Range
Light vibration	Well below 5 mm/s
Moderate vibration	Up to about 5–10 mm/s
Heavy vibration	10 mm/s or more

Note: Heavy vibration is not expected during this stage of work.

Working Hours

Construction will continue to follow the City of Toronto's bylaw-approved hours:

- Monday to Friday: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday: 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- No work will take place on Saturday, November 1 or November 8
- No work on Sundays or statutory holidays.
