Overnight Work on Cathedral Bluffs Drive from Kingston Road to Sloley Road

Contract: 25ECS-LU-07SU
Start Date: May 5, 2025 | End Date: October 31, 2025
*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto's work on Cathedral Bluffs Drive from Kingston Road to Sloley Road is progressing well and all major work is anticipated to be completed on time. This notice is to provide an update on upcoming overnight road works.

From **Wednesday**, **October 15 to Thursday**, **October 23**, **2025**, the contractor will complete overnight pavement markings and joint sealing of the newly paved asphalt. The contractor is permitted to work overnight to reduce the impact on traffic.

When this overnight work is complete, regular work hours will resume, and the road will be opened to maintain a minimum of one lane in each direction. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

The contractor has:

- Completed watermain and water service replacement.
- Removed and replaced concrete sidewalks and curbs
- Restored boulevards and driveways impacted by construction

REMAINING WORK

The contractor will:

- Complete permanent road restoration and pavement markings.
- Complete route and sealing of newly paved roads.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road, sidewalk and bikeway restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible.
