# Watermain Replacement and Road Resurfacing on Dunloe Road from Coulson Avenue to Old Forest Hill Road

Contract: 25ECS-LU-07SU Start Date: April 21, 2025


PREVIOUS End Date: September 8, 2025 | NEW End Date: October 10, 2025

This notice provides an update on resurfacing the road and replacing the watermain and the Cityowned portion of substandard water services on Dunloe Road from Coulson Avenue to Old Forest Hill Road.

Work on Dunloe Road is progressing well; however, the end date has been delayed on this project due to unforeseen poor road base conditions requiring additional work.

To date the City's contractor has completed:

- Watermain and water service replacement
- Temporary restoration

#### **REMAINING WORK**

Work crews will:

Repair the road base and resurfacing the road



**Work Hours**: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.




**Traffic Management**: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.

Traffic on Dunloe Road will be reduced to one lane.

Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated

Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will

Parking Violation Notice: Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times. If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:

1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person

(follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction.

If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy.

Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (e.g. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).

In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.

**Accessible Accommodation:** The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
