DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on November 5, 2025, as follows:

"The Motorized Refreshment Vehicle licence shall be subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Food From East Express Inc. is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Food From East Express Inc. and its directors and officers, and conduct other investigations as appropriate, to assess the licensee's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (2) During the probationary period, if MLS has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Food From East Inc., or any other concerns with respect to its conduct or the conduct of its directors and officers, those matters and Report No. 8008 and any updating material may be returned to the Tribunal for a hearing."
