35 Bellevue Ave Work Notice: Concrete Pour on Tuesday, November 25, 2025, Weather Permitting

On Tuesday, November 25, weather permitting, crews will be pouring a large concrete slab at the Bellevue site starting at **7:00 am**. Concrete must be poured and finished in one continuous operation. Once the pour begins, the team must stay with it until the slab is fully set and finished. Stopping part-way isn't an option without risking defects that would require starting again which would be costly and disruptive.

Because the setting time depends on temperature and weather, unfortunately we cannot predict the exact end time. Crews may need to work past 7:00 pm and possibly later into the evening to complete the slab in one go.

What to expect on Tuesday, November 25th, weather permitting:

- **Concrete trucks** arriving throughout the day
- **Finishing work** once the concrete begins to set
- **Four power trowels** used for finishing
 - These machines **look and sound similar to a lawn mower**
- **Diesel Light Tower (LED)**
