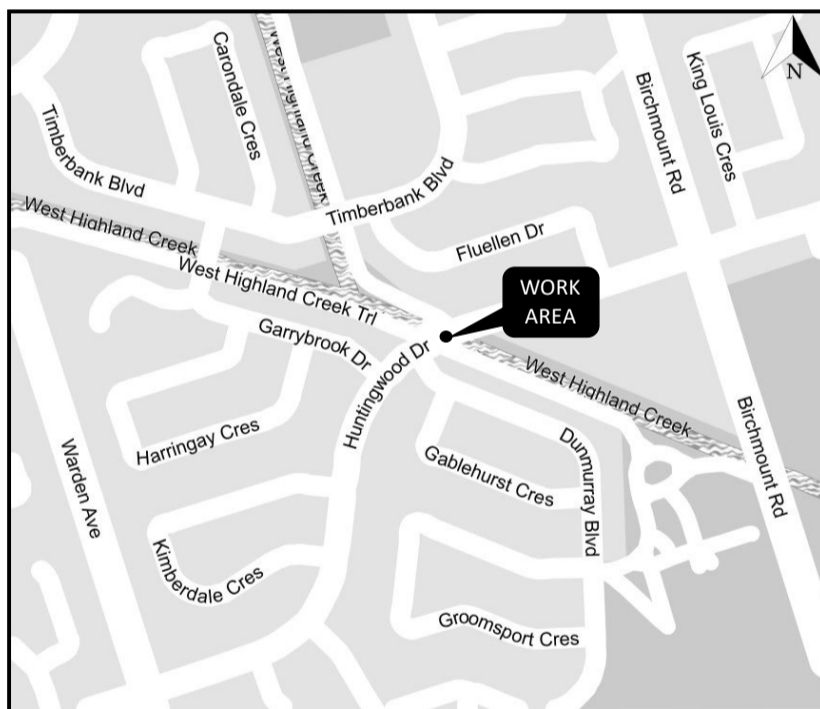

This notice provides an update on the culvert replacement project at Huntingwood Drive over the West Highland Creek.

This notice provides an update on the culvert replacement project at Huntingwood Drive over the West Highland Creek. Work on this project is currently behind schedule due to the relocation of existing electrical infrastructure and delays in procuring required materials. In addition, unexpected issues were encountered with an existing pedestrian crossing that needed to be removed for road widening.

We understand this project has an impact on all residents in the area. We sympathize and appreciate your patience as we complete this work.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

The City's contractor has completed the following on the North side of Huntingwood Drive over West Highland Creek (Stage 1 of construction):

- Replaced the existing culvert
- Removed existing concrete retaining walls, and installation of precast concrete retaining walls
- Removed and replaced gabion baskets to facilitate construction access
- Installed chain-link fence above new retaining walls
- Roadway reconstruction and active transportation works including paving, waterproofing and boulevard works

REMAINING WORK







The City's contractor will complete the following on the South side of Huntingwood Drive over West Highland Creek (Stage 2 of construction):

- Replace the existing culvert
- Remove existing concrete retaining walls, and installation of precast concrete retaining walls
- Remove and replace gabion baskets to facilitate construction access
- Install chain-link fence above new retaining walls

- Roadway reconstruction and active transportation works including paving, waterproofing and boulevard works

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with one sidewalk opened at all times. A temporary signalized pedestrian crossing will be utilized to maintain pedestrian traffic during all stages. Pedestrians will be required to cross the road at the nearest crosswalk to access the opened sidewalk during construction.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <p>Traffic on Huntingwood Drive will be reduced to a one lane of traffic in each direction for the duration of construction. The existing TTC bus stop on the south side of Huntingwood Drive will be relocated to accommodate construction.</p>
	<p>Cyclists: During construction the cycle track/bike lane will be temporarily closed through the work zone. Signs will be posted directing cyclists and drivers to share the lane, single file, through the work zone.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
	<p>TTC Impacts: Some TTC stops along Huntingwood Drive may be impacted during the work. Signage will be erected to direct bus users to temporary bus stop locations. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.</p>
