

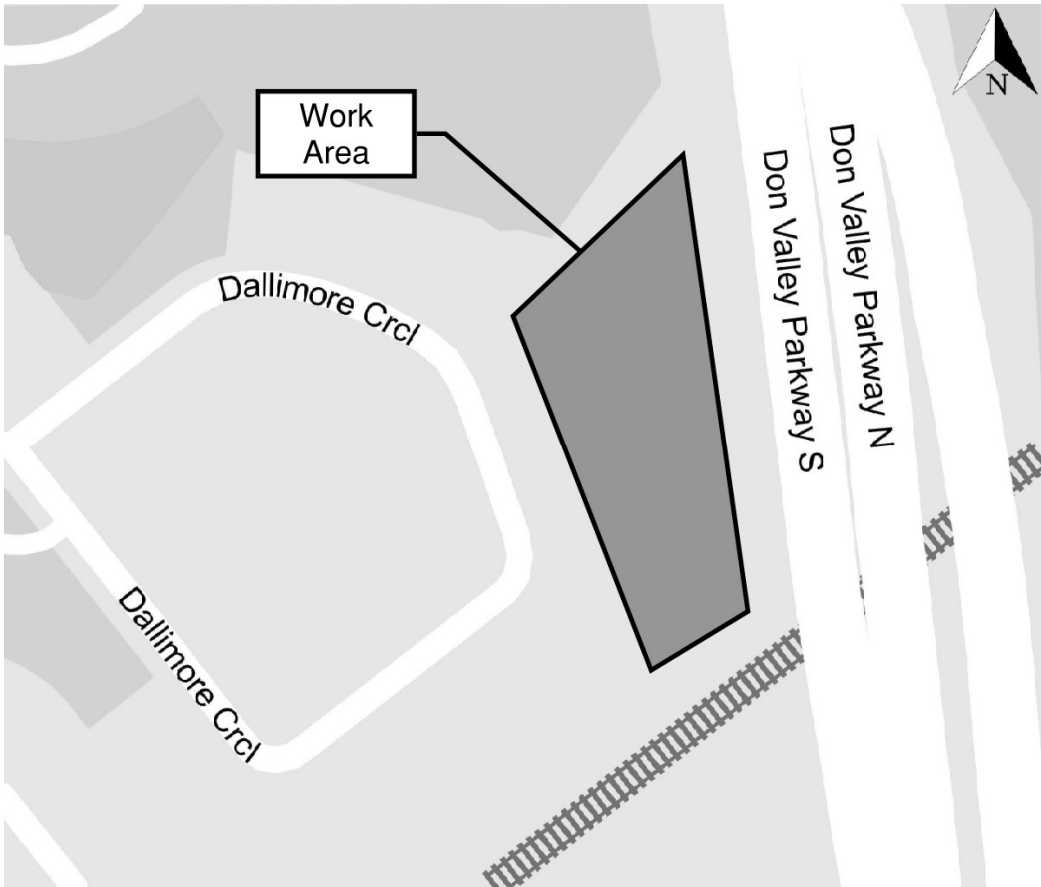

Don Valley Parkway Slope Stabilization at Dallimore Circle

Contract: 24ECS-BE-18AM
Start Date: Late March 2025 End Date: October 2025

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Don Valley Parkway Slope at Dallimore Circle. This work will ensure that the slope meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

- The City’s contractor will:
- Perform rehabilitation on the slope west of the Don Valley Parkway and east of Dallimore Circle to ensure long term structural integrity.
 - Clear and grub the work area, including the removal of trees on city property.
 - Install counterfort drains and swale system to improve slope drainage.
 - Install soil nails to stabilize the slope and prevent further degradation.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Work Hours: Work will occur between the hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday, excluding holidays. Overnight Work: Some tasks will require overnight work. During overnight work, a single lane of the southbound Don Valley Parkway (DVP) will be closed to from 11 pm to 6 am to facilitate the ingress and egress of construction vehicles into the work area.

	Pre-Construction Access: Bronte Construction and Canadian Woodland Contractors, under contract to the City of Toronto, is conducting tree removals on city property before construction starts. Affected properties should have received a letter about any actions homeowners should take prior to tree removals in the work area.
	Traffic Management: All lanes on the Don Valley Parkway (DVP) will remain open throughout construction during the day. Lanes near the working area will be shifted and realigned to accommodate construction. Night closures: The westernmost lane of the southbound Don Valley Parkway will be closed during some nights from 11 pm to 6 am to facilitate the ingress and egress of construction vehicles into the work area. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on the Don Valley Parkway near the working area.
	On-Site Communication: There are times when contractors need to communicate with homeowners about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access, water shut offs, pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility company branded clothing. If you need to speak with staff on the construction site, please ask for the Site Inspector. If the Site Inspector is unavailable, contact the person listed at the end of this notice
	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
