

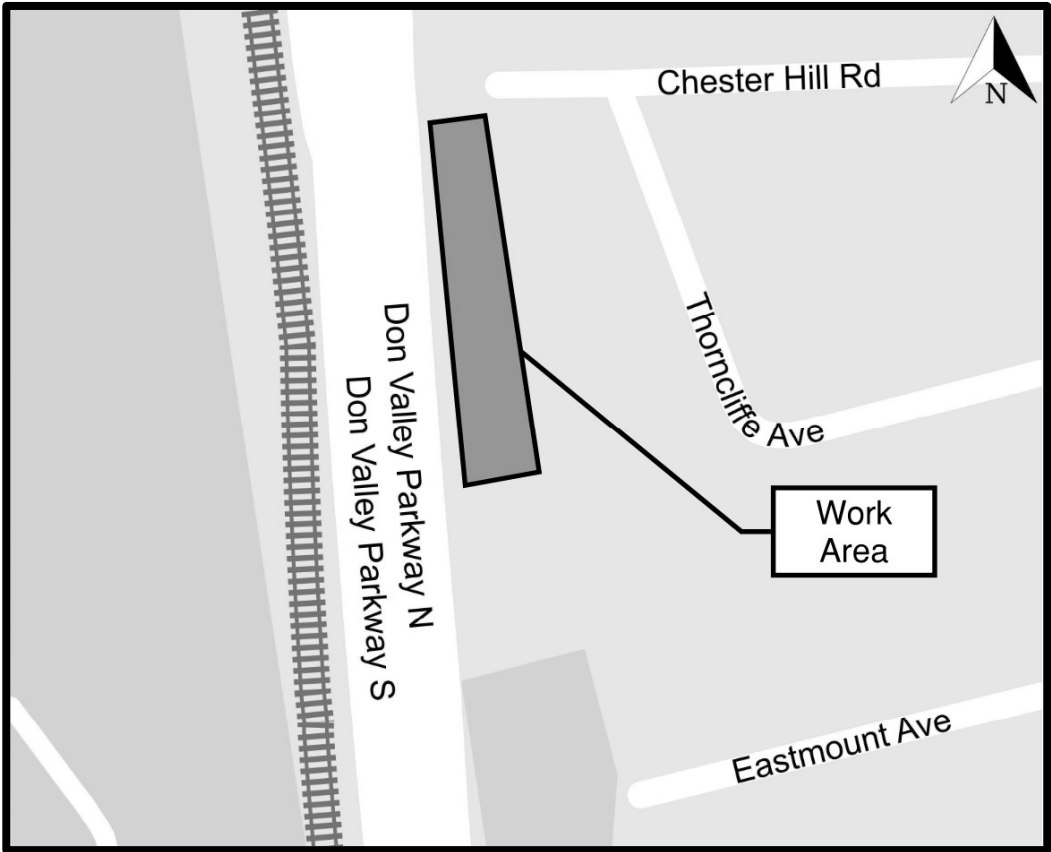

Don Valley Parkway Concrete Crib Wall Rehabilitation at Chester Hill Road

Contract: 24ECS-BE-18AM
Start Date: March 2025 End Date: October 2025

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the existing concrete crib wall adjacent to the Don Valley Parkway at Chester Hill Road. This work will ensure that the crib wall meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

In the coming weeks, the City’s contractor will:

- Set up work areas on the Don Valley Parkway shoulder
- Mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.

	Work Hours: Work will occur between the hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday, excluding holidays.
	Traffic Management: During construction, all lanes of the Don Valley Parkway (DVP) will remain open. Road users should be mindful of the narrow shoulders on the DVP near the working area. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on the DVP.
	Site Safety: Workers on site are responsible for the work assigned to them. If you have construction questions or an issue on site – ask to be directed to the site inspector. If the site inspector is unavailable, contact the person listed at the end of this notice.
