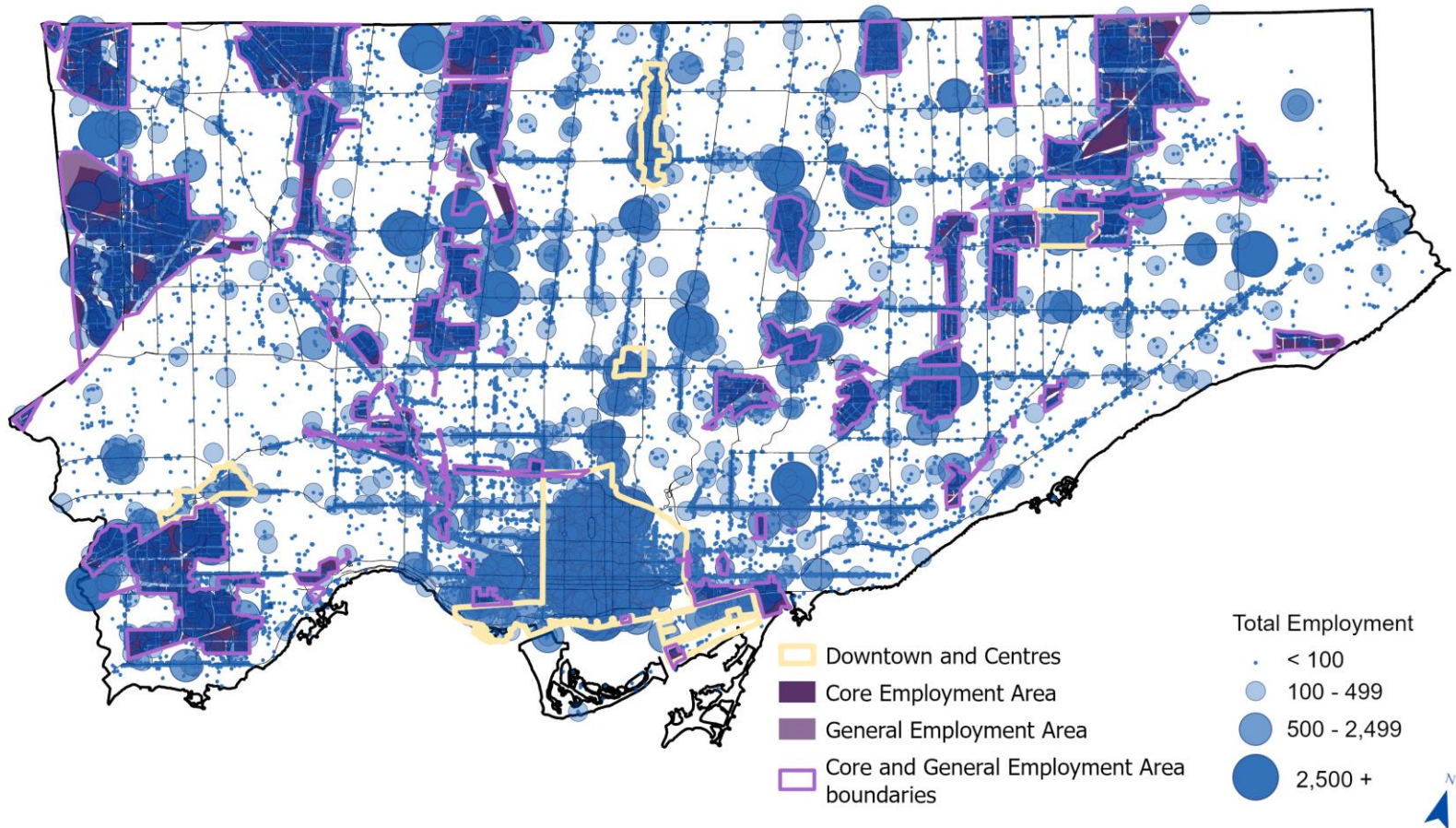

Employment Concentrations across Toronto

Employment Areas contain 381,270 jobs, 23.5% of the city's total.

Downtown contains 664,650 jobs, 40.9% of the city's total.

The **rest of the city** has a total of 577,790 jobs, 35.6% of the city's total.



Consistent since 2023, a **quarter** of businesses reporting hybrid work have employees **work on-site three days** a week on average.



Tariff-Exposed Sectors experienced a **2.8%** decrease in employment, with **208,110 jobs** now exposed.
