Gardiner Expressway Rehabilitation: Section 3 Early Works on Five Bridges Overnight Closure of Park Lawn Road at Gardiner Expressway & Project Timeline Update

This notice provides an update on the Gardiner Expressway Rehabilitation: Section 3 Early Works on Five Bridges project.

OVERNIGHT DEMOLITION - DECEMBER 13 - 14, 2025

As part of this project, overnight demolition activities will be taking place from 11 p.m. on Saturday, December 13 until 11 a.m. Sunday, December 14, to remove the south portion of the Gardiner Expressway that runs over Park Lawn Road.

To safely complete this work, a full overnight closure of Park Lawn Road will be required from the Park Lawn Road on-ramp to the Gardiner Expressway westbound (north limit) to the Gardiner Expressway eastbound off-ramp to Park Lawn Road (south limit). This work is being completed overnight when traffic volumes are lower to help ensure the safety of crews and the travelling public.

PROJECT TIMELINE UPDATE


Due to site conditions that required additional investigation and design revisions, work on the bridges at Kipling and Islington Avenues over the Gardiner Expressway will extend beyond the original 2025 completion date and is now expected to be completed **May 2026**.

As a result, construction on the Park Lawn Road on-ramp to the westbound Gardiner Expressway has been delayed and is expected to begin in **August 2026 and continue until December 2026.** A more detailed construction notice regarding the Park Lawn Road on-ramp work will be sent out prior to construction starting.

While work on the Kipling and Islington bridges has been extended, the overall project completion of December 2026 is not expected to be impacted.

We thank you for your patience and understanding as this essential infrastructure work continues to progress.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING OVERNIGHT DEMOLITION WORK

The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays. Your patience is appreciated.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone.

Sidewalks along Park Lawn Road will be closed for the duration of the full closure noted above. Sidewalks will be closed from the Park Lawn Road on-ramp to the Gardiner Expressway westbound (north limit) to the Gardiner Expressway eastbound off-ramp to Park Lawn Road (south limit).



Traffic Management:

- The Park Lawn Road on-ramp towards Gardiner Expressway westbound will remain open for the duration of the work.
- The Gardiner Expressway eastbound off-ramp to Park Lawn Road will only have access to southbound Park Lawn Road for the duration of the work.
- Northbound traffic on Park Lawn Road from the off-ramp will be closed for the duration of the full closure noted above.
- Signage will be posted.



TTC Service Changes:

This work will impact the 66 Prince Edward TTC bus route. Visit ttc.ca/service-advisories/Service-Changes for the latest updates.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction.
