Night Work on Clinton Street from Bloor Street to College Street

Contract: 25ECS-LU-02SU Start Date: July 14, 2025 End Date: May 2026

*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto's work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Clinton Street is progressing well.

To facilitate water service connections and minimize impact to daytime traffic and service disruption, construction will take place during the night. Please see below for additional details:

 Work on Clinton Street from Bloor Street to College Street will start on Sunday, November 30, starting at 7 p.m. and will continue until the morning of Friday, December 5, at 7 a.m.

Residents should expect construction noise in the immediate work zone. In the event of inclement weather or other delays to the work, the work will be deferred or extended to subsequent nights.

We know this project has an impact to residents and businesses along Clinton Street. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences.

	 Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required. Nightwork is scheduled to commence on Sunday, November 30, at 7 p.m. and will continue until morning of Friday, December 5, at 7 a.m.
٤	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	Driveway Access: The contractor will coordinate driveway access requirements and will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
\$	Traffic Management : Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.
	Local traffic will be maintained during the duration of this work.



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Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. This project will affect on-street parking. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call **416-808-2222** for its location.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
