The portion of the property municipally known as 2027 Kipling Avenue, Toronto, legally described as LT 27, CON A **Property** ON HUMBER AS IN EB352629 ETOBICOKE, CITY OF TORONTO on PIN 07336-0161 (LT) Actions Authority be granted to enter into the Licence Agreement with the Licensee, substantially on the major terms and conditions set out in Appendix "A", and including such other amended terms as deemed appropriate by the approving authority herein, and in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor. **Financial Impact** No Financial Impact. Nominal licence for the purpose of environmental testing. Comments GHD Limited has proposed to conduct an environmental investigation on City-owned lands adjacent to the former Canadian Tire Corporation (CTC) gas bar/pit stop located at 2027 Kipling Avenue. Soil and groundwater impacts were found on the Canadian Tire site in close proximity to the northeast property boundary in 2022. GHD is planning to investigate if the impacts have migrated off-Site. Proposed activities to be completed are as follows: public/private utility locates (one day), daylighting activities (one day), drilling up to 8 boreholes [depth: 4 m, (one to two days)], monitoring well installation (contingent), field surveying for horizontal and vertical control (one day) and any additional activities related to the investigation. The proposed Licence fee and other major terms and conditions of the Licence Agreement are considered to be fair, reasonable. **Terms** Term: Six (6) Months commencing on November 1, 2025 and expiring on April 30, 2026. Use: Borehole drilling and monitoring well installations for environmental, geotechnical and hydrogeological investigations. Area: Approximately 100 metres squared. Licence Fee: Nominal. Early Termination: Licensee or the City have the right to terminate on fourteen (14) day's written notice. Restoration: Upon expiry/termination, the Licensee shall immediately remove all fixture(s), equipment, structures and debris and shall restore the Licensed Area, to the extent practicable, to its original condition immediately prior to the Licensee's occupancy. Insurance: Commercial General Liability, in an amount of not less than \$2,000,000,000 per occurrence and Professional Liability (Errors and Omissions) coverage in the amount not less than \$1,000,000,00 and includes professional services pollution liability insurance.
