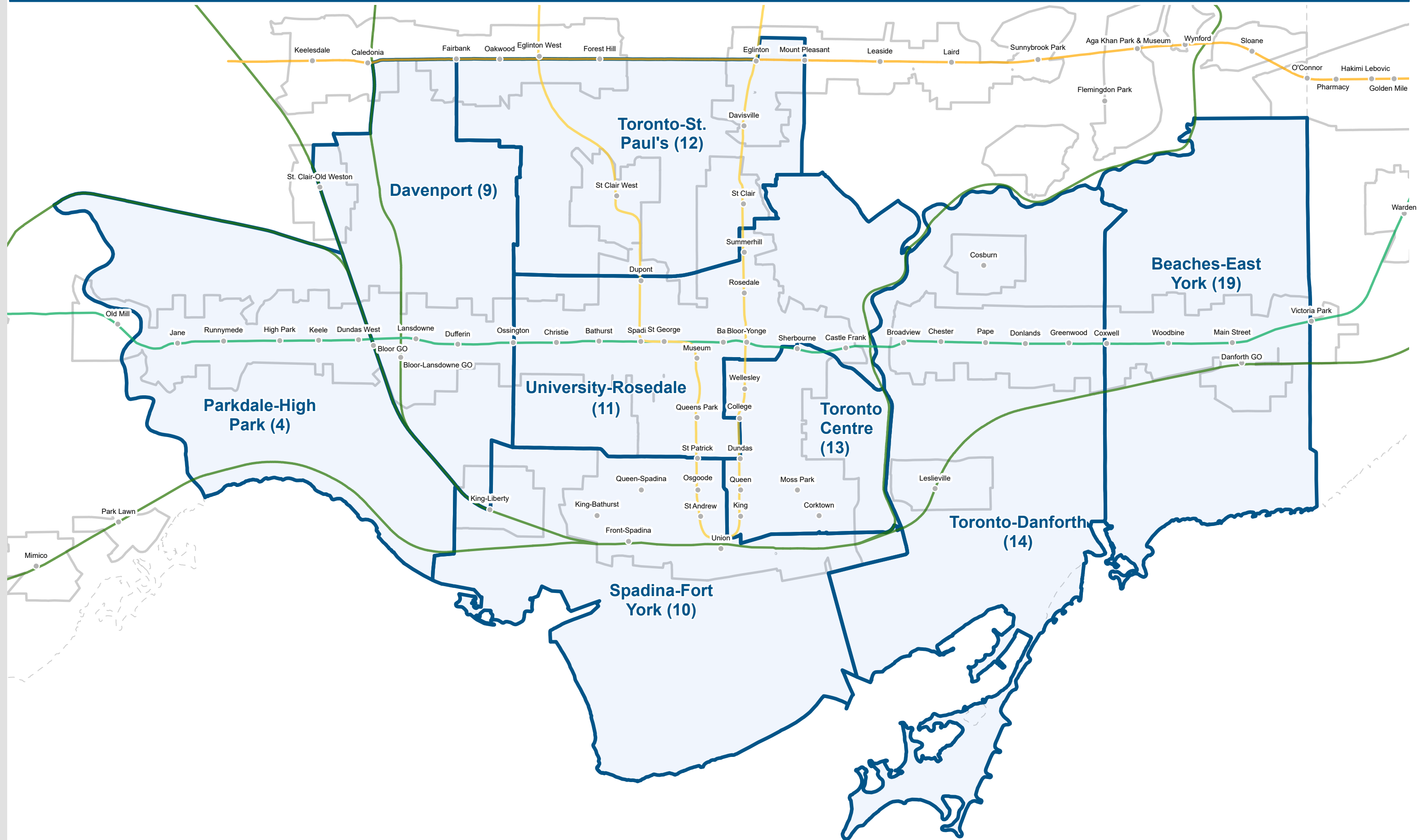

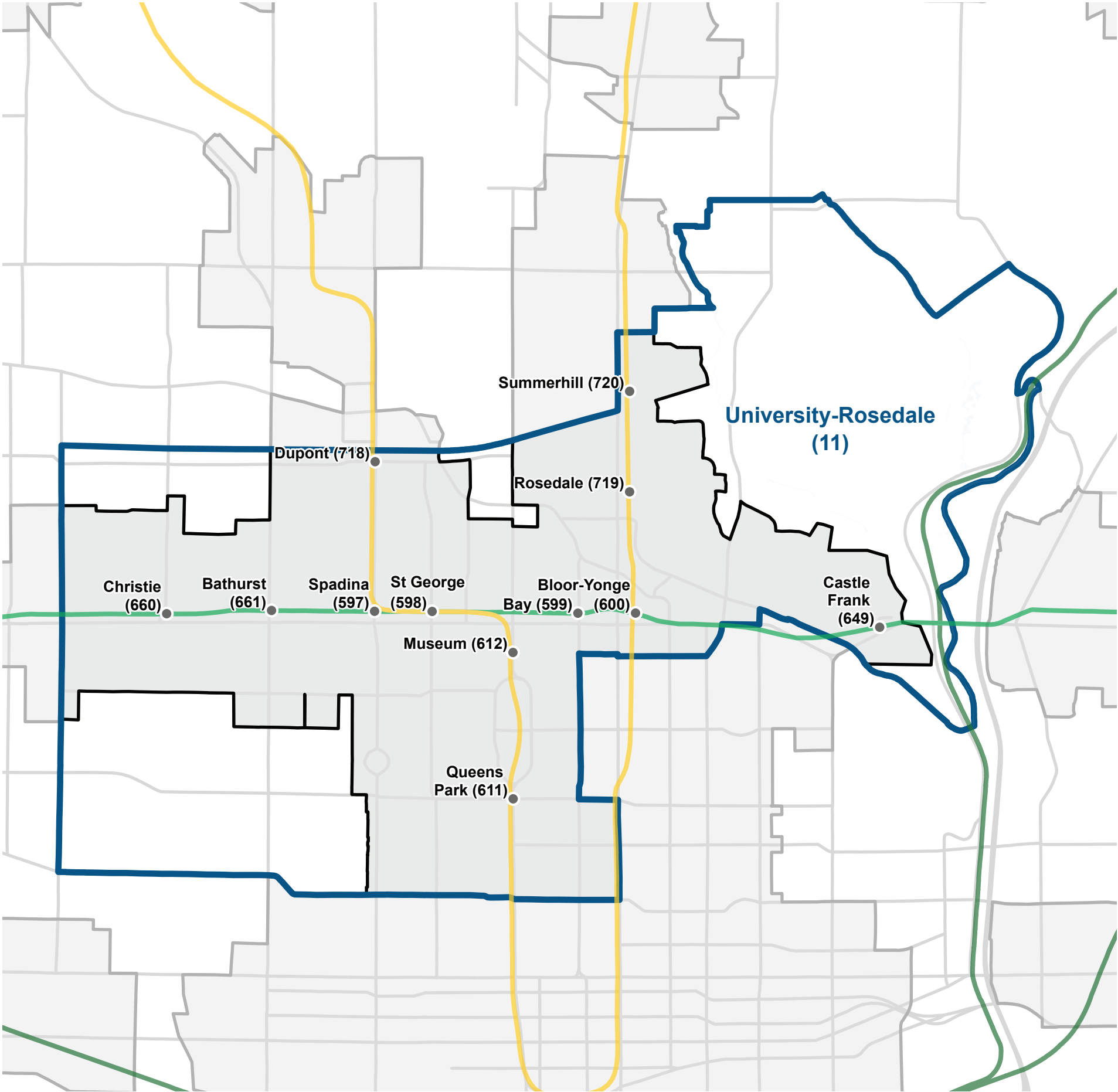


TORONTO EAST YORK INDEX KEY

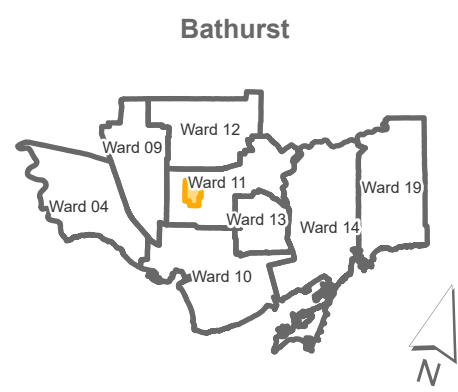

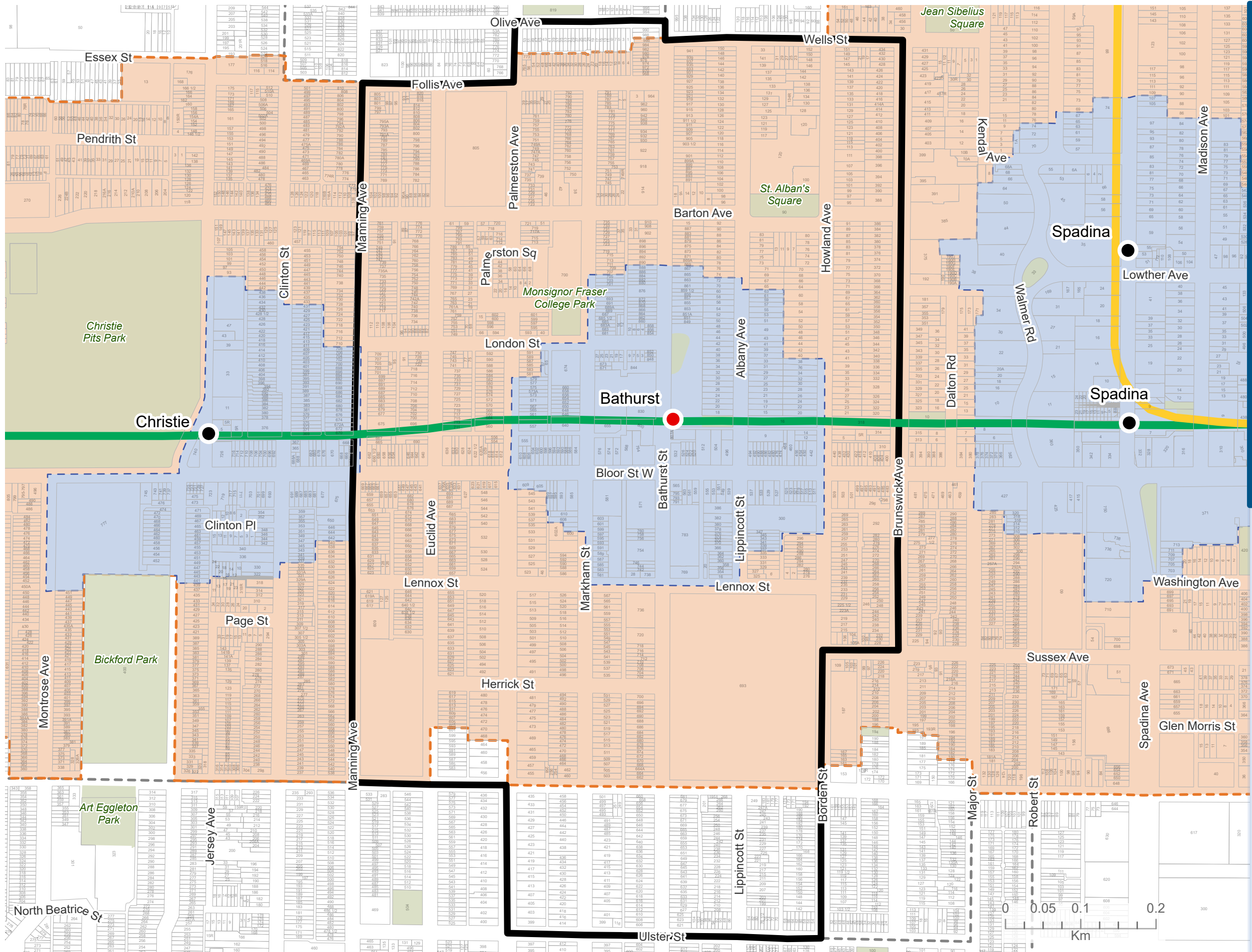

Within Special Policy Areas, the MTSA policies identify a minimum development density of 0 FSI and do not provide additional height or density permissions.
